Awarding stimulus funds in these areas would duplicate facilities already in place. This duplication is not a wise expenditure of public funds. The duplication of facilities also jeopardizes the viability of existing service providers, jobs, and sustainable economic stability. Our network meets and exceeds the speeds listed as the minimum in the NOFA 2. There is established competition in this area. As you can see by the documentation provided, the majority of our serving territory has speeds of up to 20 Mbps of service available. These high speeds coupled with the presence of competition, these areas are well served and no stimulus funds are necessary.
