- AVFN has learned that finalization of fiber routes, both primary and alternate routes, is a critical path item for commencement and completion of the environmental assessment process. EA consultants must have clear and documented fiber route maps in order to perform the necessary surveys. AVFN advises other applicants to begin the process of route finalization as early as possible.

- AVFN has learned that resolving potential duplication of funding issues (AKA overlaps) is a time-consuming process. Other applicants often do not share the same urgency to resolve these issues, and are often unwilling or unable to share detailed street-level maps. AVFN advises other applicants to begin the process to resolve such overlaps as early as possible.

- AVFN has learned that securing the eventual commitment of community anchor institutions is an ongoing, time-consuming process. While project planning and construction is underway, applicants must also be communicating consistently with potential CAIs to educate them on the services the network will offer, stay up to date on deadlines (e.g. eRate) faced by those CAIs, set the CAIs expectations on when service will be available, and educate CAIs on the importance of CAI commitment to the network.
