Project engineering and environmental assessment have been completed at the end of the quarter with the draft environmental assessment submitted for BTOP review on 04/14/2011. The engineers and Nexus reviewed an alternate route for services from Jonesboro to Weston utilizing fiber in lieu of microwave and concluded this change could be implemented within the project scope and budget to provide better long range services to the community. For the fiber route, staking has been completed and co-location/ repeater sites confirmed. The engineering firm is currently reviewing potential bidder qualifications. Interviews with fiber and other materials suppliers have begun to secure materials in advance of contractor bid packages. Elements necessary for the bid package have been assembled with bids due for release within 30 days after approval of the environmental assessment.

Challenges related to the environmental assessment, but aggressive schedules from our environmental consultant along with outstanding assistance from BTOP personnel have completed the draft assessment to help get the project back to a acceptable schedule. Additional challenges related to highway right of way permits due to existing construction on some portions of the route along with some protected surface segments which required slight changes in the route. The Louisiana Department of Highways (DOT) offered assistance to mitigate the issues. In the original budget submitted, the plan was for a "design build" project whereby the awarded contractor performed much of the environmental and engineering design as part of the construction bid submitted. The construction segment reflected these costs. The engineering budget provided only for CAD and drawings. To provide the most competitive construction bids, Nexus separated all engineering and therefore the engineering category is over budget. The additional monies required will be moved from the construction budget. The change will not negatively impact the construction funding required to complete the project. Nexus Systems provided for 26% matching funding in the project in both cash and in-kind match. All in-kind match and a significant portion of the cash match will be reflected in the Q2 Progress Report which will provide match in excess of the proportion of expenditures to date.

Possible challenges relate to the procurement of fiber materials as we see the lead times for these products becoming longer. Permits for the railway crossings are pending as of the end of the quarter. Procedure for rail permits in the past has been for the rail company to only issue permit to the awarded contractor due to insurance requirements placed on the contractor. After the end of the quarter, we successfully negotiated a change in the procedure to issue permits directly to Nexus Systems and permits will therefore not impede the construction process.
