The providers are then asked if the map characterized their system boundaries and service levels correctly. Based on the provider's feedback, the map is adjusted and refined accordingly, creating our initial or coverage maps. 2. On-site Field Verification Methods, November 2011: The back lab verification processes described above will create the basis for the field verification process, there will be multiple methodologies utilized to further verify the accuracy of information gathered from the providers. These methods will vary based on the technologies. For instance, cable television-based broadband provider infrastructure can be verified based on whether infrastructure exists at a given location. Generally, if a cable TV provider offers cable modem-based broadband services in any part of a system, it will be available throughout the system. 3. Public website & Speed test: The State of Delaware established a dedicated website to display broadband coverage, with the ability to collect public feedback via broadband.delaware.gov website.
