In addition, PCI discovered an error in the census block data from the last submission and in some carrier submitted speeds, and has corrected those errors in the existing database, and will work to ensure that all carrier data is submitted correctly in the next submission.

The data team has been pleased to see the data gathered be used to assist PCl's other projects.
