Project Indicators (This Quarter)

1. Please describe significant project accomplishments completed during this quarter (600 words or less).

Connect Ohio worked with participants to adjust their ongoing involvement with the Every Citizen Online program. There are currently 78 confirmed sub-recipients and 65 that have launched classes. 9,140 students are registered for classes. 7,646 students have taken at least one hour of training of which 4,763 completed training, 5,848 Instructor Hours have been delivered. 574 computers have been distributed to sub-recipients.

Sub-recipients have offered bi-lingual classes to participants.

Field managers have conducted monthly meetings with sub-recipients in each of 24 regions across the state.

New public service announcements (PSAs) for television have been created. 15,000 PSAs have aired on 34 television stations, 63,000 PSAs have aired on 122 radio stations, and PSAs run in 95 newspapers weekly. The PSAs have generated approximately 200 million impressions with an additional 2.8 million impressions from 107 press releases sent to local and state news organizations. Through our YouTube PSA development contest, 2 winners and 2 honorable mentions were announced and awarded. A computer giveaway contest was held to stimulate ECO participation and survey completion. Twelve participants were chosen by random draw and were awarded computers.

The call center, handling response from PSAs, has processed 3,315 calls representing 586 ZIP codes across the state. Enhancements to the SharePoint program reporting system have been made, reviewed, and are ready for implementation.

Survey information collected from ECO participants is accessible in real time and an analysis summary is provided each month. 1,765 surveys were completed and 87% indicated they would subscribe to broadband within the next year.

During this past quarter, some individuals registered for training classes but did not attend those classes. The primary reason for under attended classes is that this training if offered for free. As such registrants are finding it easy to ignore their scheduled training if a schedule conflict arises.

Sub-recipients are trying to mitigate this trend using the following tactics:

- 1. Training facilities are routinely contacting registrants prior to scheduled training to remind them of their class and offer to reschedule them if a conflict exists.
- 2. Whenever possible training facilities are attempting to over-book or otherwise postpone classes until there is enough demand to ensure the class will be better attended.
- 3. Training facilities are scheduling class sessions in closer proximity (eg. three days in a row as opposed to one day over three weeks), which has proven to improve follow-on attendance.
- 4. Training facilities are engaging training participants to encourage their friends, family and coworkers to join them in a class. This

peer-pressure has proven to improve not only attendance but overall class dynamics as well.

New Household Subscribers is a calculation of the number of participants who have taken at least one hour of training multiplied by the percentage of participants who indicate their intent to subscribe for household use, but not for business use. This percentage will vary quarter to quarter as survey responses vary.
