Audit of Wireless Broadband Availability Reporting: Development has begun on Fixed Wireless propagation mapping , with key inputs being transmitter location and, where available, data on spectrum power levels and other relevant transmission factors provided by carriers and/or supplemented by data available from the FCC, public web sites and other sources. This dataset is used as a source to determine gaps in provider submitted wireless service area coverage, as well as a source for providing service areas coverage for non-participating fixed wireless providers. The Prior Mapping data is also used as a validation source for gap analysis. Due to a lack of provider tower and antenna data, deployment of this audit of Wireless Broadband Availability is planned for the October 1, 2012 delivery to the NTIA. New avenues for acquiring the needed tower and antenna information are being explored from the FCC, State Wireless Associations and Area Development Districts.

Our contractor, Michael Baker Inc., submitted a white paper describing the DATA DEVELOPMENT & VALIDATION METHODOLOGIES with the April 2012 data submission to the NTIA.

The Commonwealth continues to encounter challenges and obstacles with the collection of data from community anchor institutions (CAI). We have identified appropriate stakeholders in the various areas, however, responses to queries and requests for data remain to be sporadic and undependable. We continue to work with our subcontractors to develop tools to make it as easy as possible for entities to supply us with the requested information. As previously reported, we focused our efforts on the collection of K-12 public schools. Unfortunately, the Kentucky Department of Education was not able to provide any broadband data for each K-12 public school. Additional outreach activities are being identified to collect this data. During the 1st quarter, we have setup a broadband data collections procedure with the Governor's Office of Electronic Health Information (GOEHI) in the Cabinet for Health and Family Services who is responsible for the Kentucky Health Information Exchange. The KHIE will begin conducting surveys of hospitals and has agreed to collect the required SBI broadband information for the healthcare facilities. Each CAI healthcare record in our SBI database has been linked to the e-Health database and we anticipate auto loading broadband information for our October 2012 data submittal to the NTIA.
