As with previous reports, the overall project completion reported below lags the actual progress in completing installations, largely due to the lag between purchasing, installation, and drawdown of federal funds. Due to favorable pricing, we are running well ahead of expectations for the number of computers installed, with 3287 computers already installed. Other metrics for people served and training activities are on target.
