The project milestones for Leading Practices activities have now been planned out. For more details, please refer to the Q1 Supplemental Answers Document. We have also planed out the milestones for the addressing effort and have sent it to NTIA. Efforts are currently on hold until we receive approval from NTIA.

10bb. Please describe any challenge or obstacle that you have encountered and detail the mitigation strategies the project team is employing The following challenges are the same that have been reported in previous quarters and we're looking to NTIA for support/guidance to

resolve these items:

1) Address/Basemap Data - It's been noticed by Providers and public users that geocoding on the State map is not locating some of their addresses. This is due to the address data available for the State, as many street level data does not have detailed and current address-level data in rural areas. Mississippi did request grant approval for a Master Address File to build up a stronger basemap, which would help alleviate this challenge, but funding was denied.

Update from previous report: NTIA has approved to use the \$500,000 in the "Other" section for address improvement, which we're hoping to start in year 2 of the program if NTIA agrees.

- 2) With the verification efforts continuing, there's a challenge balancing conflicts identified during the verification process and requesting updates or correctness in data collected/reported by the provider. Need to ensure the map is an accurate representation of broadband availability, but also need to ensure cooperativeness of the providers themselves.
- 3) The last challenge is the 2nd priority feedback item on the interactive map, where provider coverage displayed is being questioned by the public as it represents either too generalized of a footprint (census block) or is completely missing as resellers are not included. Need support from NTIA/FCC on future model changes to incorporate better requirements for reseller and business-only providers.

The Planning team in the Office of the Governor worked with Fidelis Policy Group to prepare for and coordinate major activities including the September 28th Board of Directors meeting and the third round of Mississippi Broadband Connect Coalitions committee meetings. These events required a great deal of professional management and support. At this time, a first draft of the final report has been created and is being edited.

Additionally, the Mississippi State University Extension Service hired six regional coordinators in July as well as a part-time technical assistance person and an evaluator. The team developed a vision and mission statement to help communicate its overarching purpose. Three main short to medium term goals were also developed, namely: (1) pursue community outreach and awareness; (2) identify and assess regional broadband uses, applications, and infrastructure; and (3) gear up for the establishment of regional advisory councils.
