The last quarter has gone well.

11l. Please provide any other information that you think would be useful to NTIA as it assesses your Broadband Mapping Project One Economy (OE) conducted a trip to Guam at the end of January to conduct a second round of community engagement. OE met with the local government, telecoms, media and hosted tow town hall meetings and a focus group with underserved communities. The town halls and meetings with the providers have led to revisions in the data submitted to the national broadband map. We have found a small number of un-served subdivisions in the southern towns of Umatac and Inarajan, which were previously listed as served by the island's ISPs. Additionally, we have found that access to broadband in Guam is not really a barrier to adoption, and that the real barrier to adoption is the cost. The populations who use broadband least are the poorest communities, often immigrants from Micronesia. OE continues to delve deeper into these findings to verify them and further explain them. We are also working hard to get communities around Guam to take the speed test, so we can compare advertised and typical speeds.
