Please provide any other information that you think would be useful to NTIA as it assesses your Broadband Mapping Project Though we have just begun our analysis of the community survey, we have found some initial findings that are very interesting. The early data confirms that one of the least served groups of people is the immigrant community, especially those from Micronesian islands.. The ratio of those who use broadband to those who don't from that community is much lower than for the population in general. Also, unsurprisingly, we have found that further educational attainment correlates with higher broadband use. We will continue to analyze the data in the next quarter and hope to find deeper and more meaningful trends that will be able to inform our policy and broadband inclusion recommendations.
