Additionally, we have found that access to broadband in Guam is not really a barrier to adoption, and that the real barrier to adoption is the cost. The populations who use broadband the least are the poorest communities, often immigrants from Micronesia. OE hopes to delve deeper into these findings to verify them and further explain them.
