ENA was notified of our award at the end of February 2010 and thus there have been limited activities and progress during the first quarter of 2010. No federal or matching fund expenditures have been obligated to date. We were granted a categorical exclusion for an environmental assessment and therefore we have no activities related to that milestone.

During the month of March 2010, we re-engaged the Community Anchor Institutions that we plan to serve and have collaborated to select our sites for our Wave 1 (Calendar Year 2010) deployment. As of March 31, 2010, we began network engineering for all Wave 1 sites and expect to transition into the other key milestone categories in the second quarter of 2010.

At this point, we are finding that there has been some infrastructure construction in some of the areas that we expect to be part of our Wave 1 deployment since our application submission in August 2009. In order to ensure that stimulus funds are spent most appropriately, we are engaging directly with the parties who have expanded their presence to determine if we can leverage their facilities to more cost effectively accomplish our project goals. We intend to report the results of these discussions as they related to our Wave 1 sites during the second and third quarter of 2010.

During the second quarter of 2010, we anticipate completing network design for our Wave 1 deployment sites, finalizing vendor selections, complete right of way determinations and access, and begin obtaining our construction permits and other approvals. In parallel to the right of way and permit determinations and acquisition, we will begin site preparation for our Wave 1 sites as well as make preparations for equipment procurement in the third quarter of 2010. Network build for Wave 1 sites may begin during the last few weeks of the second quarter if we have received sufficient permits and finalized any remaining right of way approvals. No federal funds are expected to be obligated or paid during the second quarter of 2010 as ENA is not obligated to make payment until after the end of the construction process at each site.

Additionally, during the second quarter of 2010 we plan to create our initial list of Wave 2 sites. Our expectation is that Wave 2 deployment preparations will begin at the end the third quarter of 2010 with anticipated completion during the second quarter of 2011.
