<b>REASON(S) FOR AMENDMENT</b> 1. To partially lift the grant suspension of the Buggs Island award in order for Buggs Island Telephone Cooperative to secure a third-party partner to address technical, organizational, and financial concerns with its BTOP-funded project and to complete federal reporting requirements. During this period, only expenses for the above mentioned activities, expenses related to reporting, and those expenses outlined in the January 4, 2013 letter, which is incorporated by reference, are allowable under the award.  Buggs Island Telephone Cooperative will remain on agency review status. Additionally, the Buggs Island CAP response remains under review, and the NOAA Grants Office and NTIA may request additional documentation or other information to clarify any questions relating to the CAP response.  2. To revise NOAA Administrative Standard Award Conditions.
