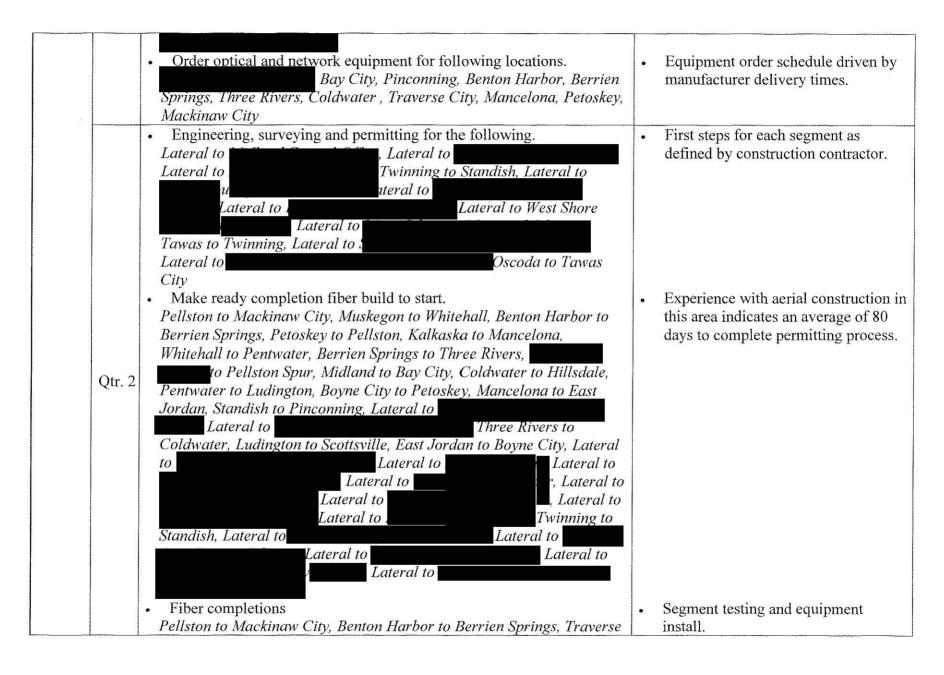

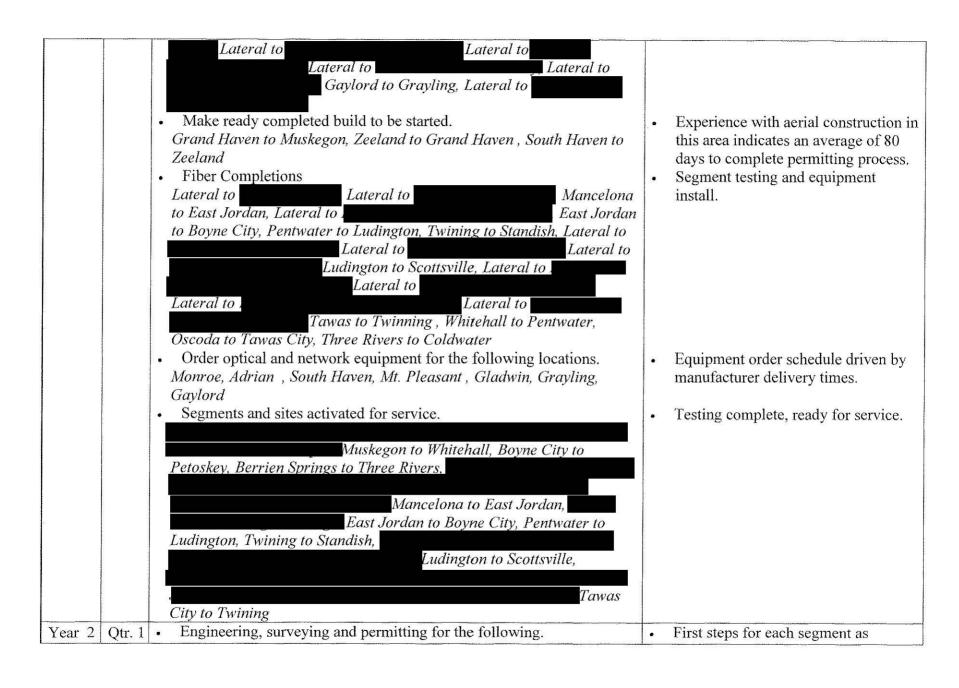

KEY CHALLENGES

- Weather in the Michigan region restricts underground construction from approximately November to April in the northern areas and January to March in the southern areas. Mitigation is to plan underground work outside these months.
- Variations in geography can restrict construction. Swamps, large rocks, etc may prevent construction on the desired path. Mitigation is to reroute around the obstacle.
- Permit granting on aerial right of way can be highly variable in terms of time and costs. Experience has shown that problematic aerial paths (large amounts of make ready required) are best bypassed by rerouting on alternate roadways or going underground. A balance between high make ready costs and the increased cost of going underground needs to be maintained.
- Fiber availability varies with manufacturer's production schedule. Order of work can be altered to continue building infrastructure and install fiber at a later time. This may increase cost due to dispatching construction crews multiple times.
- In order to ensure projects move forward without delay, the State of Michigan is developing a multi-agency coordinating committee comprised of management level staff from each of the agencies involved in the permitting or approval process. The committee will be responsible for expediting and/or resolving any issues that develop with regard to broadband project permitting. In addition, in order to minimize the time associated with the review and approval process for projects related to this program, the group has developed a streamlined process for application identification, submittal and processing. Applicants awarded funds for broadband infrastructure projects will be notified by letter of the expedited process and contact information for the committee.

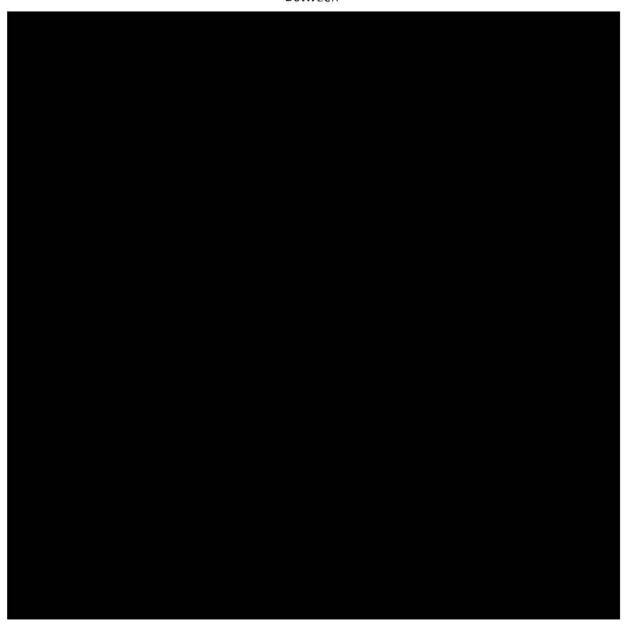
