During first quarter of 2013, the Decorah sub-recipient completed its fiber installation. As of March 31, 2013, the Iowa Communications Network has drawn down \$12.8 million of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds. IRU deliveries are back on schedule and the project remains on track for an on time completion The Iowa Communications Network expects to draw remaining budgeted funds during the 2nd quarter of 2013. The Meskwaki Tribe have been working to turn up high-speed Internet to the homes on the reservation. Difficulties were encountered due to winter weather impacting the terrain and travel to and from the homes from the main switch location. There have been 8% of the homes enabled with high-speed Internet through the 1st quarter of 2013. Additionally, the Meskwaki Settlement School and the Meskwaki Tribal Government Offices were enabled with high-speed Internet.

Since these sites were to eventually be upgraded through BTOP, these upgrades were completed using BTOP specifications rather than upgrading them now and then again several months later as part of BTOP. This situation has resulted in this portion of the program being greatly ahead of schedule.
