N/A - The project construction has concentrated on Middle Mile Backbone and pole make ready. Lateral connections will begin in Q1 of 2012. We anticipate benefits to both broadband speeds as well as reduced costs for those speed tiers. The project will track the historic connection speeds and costs to CAI sites for reporting purposes as they are connected to our project. Current pre-project options range from no connectivity, T1, DSL and some fiber connections, though speed is questionable because the fiber connections are typically shared among multiple CAI sites.
