The one CAI that has been connected using BTOP funding had a symmetrical broadband connection of 1.5Mbps replaced by a symmetrical 1Gbps (1,000Mbps) broadband connection. This resulted in a 66566.67% increase in broadband speed (increase = (new amount - original amount)/original amount. In both cases this is a transport circuit only between the school and the central technology center for the school system. The internet connectivity is centralized and shared with all schools in the school system from the technology center.
