### 1. Please describe significant project accomplishments completed during this quarter (600 words or less).

On 07/29/2010, NebraskaLink was awarded an NTIA / BTOP Stimulus grant. We began construction in 05/2011 and finished in 06/2013. We completed 461 miles of optical backbone fiber builds, which when combined with our 1427 miles of leased backbone fiber totaled 1888 mile fiber optic backbone. NebraskaLink equipped the backbone with a combination of 8 and 40 wave DWDM equipment. Along the newly created backbone, NebraskaLink interconnected with 24 Nebraska telephone and cable TV companies. This allowed us to expand our service foot-print to all other areas of Nebraska, including areas not reached by our backbone network. As part of our total miles, NebraskaLink completed 71 miles of aerial and underground construction within the cities of North Platte, Kearney, O'Neill, Valentine, Sidney and Grand Island allowing us to provide fiber optic services to 101 community anchor institutions.

Benefits of the newly completed network include;

• Interconnects with communications partners – this helps us expand our footprint and provide end-to-end services to customers across the state

• Large Ethernet capacity – this allows us to sell large circuits to customers, which was not available in Nebraska prior to NebraskaLink's backbone

• Redundancy – NebraskaLink's network includes three main rings enabling us to protect circuits across the state. No other providers could provide a protected service prior to NebraskaLink's backbone

• Contracts with University system, State of Nebraska and Nebraska Schools – NebraskaLink is able to offer high quality – cost effective solutions that were not previously available.

• Competition – several communities along the NebraskaLink backbone were either unserved or underserved prior to the NebraskaLink network

• Additional Jobs – NebraskaLink has grown our staff to 14 employees since the beginning of the grant project – our project has also contributed to the work forces of our contractors
