The One-Stop Career Center Broadband Education Access Mentoring (BEAM) project is in its initial implementation stages and equipment has not yet been purchased or installed for use. However, there will be improved statewide access to training and programs via use of interactive video presence (IVP). Using IVP will enable us to increase access of vulnerable populations to: career and training initiatives; skills development; career counseling through distribution of conferences; green training; and greater collaborations between community colleges and industry in defining and delivering workforce programs. As this training will be accessible to the public at One-Stop Career Centers, extensive additional services such as resume creation and job search assistance will be readily available.
