Our biggest challenge has been that since ND has a strong rural telco industry, not all of the providers had the data readily available. After the first look at the map, there was clearly missing data. We are working with the providers to come up with a better way to gather coverage data.

For example, in the original grant the project and program management were combined, but in the amended grant, we had split those roles out. So we split the original grant funding between the two line items. However, the funds did not change categories (i.e. salaries stayed as salaries). The only funds that change categories was the \$26,000 we moved from the App Development line (salaries and benefits) to the contractor line as we are having the vendor work with the providers for the extra data updates.
