The final step that will occur in alignment with the Round 3 outreach is completed training on validation and change collection via the portal. 2. Verification - 3rd Party Source Material – This quarter we've completed 3rd party analysis on all providers' coverage areas. This data, along with the provider validation results, were combined into one overall table with an assigned confidence value on the specified coverage area. This allowed us to break each coverage area down by technology type and record verification and confidence values down to a technology type level for each provider.									
3. The Crowd Sourcing collection was integrated. Within the interactive map, the public can run speed tests and provide feedback on the available broadband technology in their area.
