If the feedback process (or any other data input) uncovers un-served or underserved areas that do not agree with our maps we will undertake the following verification activities:										
3) Field Verification of Provider physical plant (facilities). On an as needed basis perform a high level "windshield" style survey of provider facilities in areas where our maps and direct feedback do not agree. Local knowledge, broadband utility knowledge, relationships with broadband providers would all be leveraged as well as field surveys to map out the actual physical location and routes of broadband provider facilities. With this data we would also gain a more detailed knowledge of where the broadband providers have actual middle mile and last mile facilities within Rhode Island.										
4) Wireless Provider Data Verification. Same as field verification but applied to wireless broadband coverage. Utilize cutting edge wireless applications to survey wireless coverage in areas where our maps and direct feedback do not agree. The methodology to be employed will be the physical survey of determined testing locations (possibly including waterways) to test for wireless broadband service as well as capacity per each wireless provider in the identified areas. 10g.
