In this Submission, along with the standard verification by providers using the Provider Portal, we also identified for providers issues that they needed to focus on regarding the findings from our validation team. This was done by sending them a letter that identified issues using screenshots and explaining to them what the error was and then asking them to fix those errors using the secure provider portal. A sample of the letter is provided in Appendix A in this document. This helps by making this process a little more targeted for the providers and allows them to hone into issues.

We continue to use speedtest data and community anchor data crowdsourced for validation purposes.

5) Planning workshops and local validation

In this submission, we have tried very hard to incorporate and address feedback from planning workshops and local outreach conducted by State of Washington. We spoke to several providers which resulted either in a better explanation of their service area or an alteration of their service. For example, feedback from DIS and other providers resulted in a serious change in service area for Cascade and in another instance; Charter provided some clarification on why their area is correct. This will continue to be an ongoing activity with providers and we will work to resolve these issues in the months to come.
