Dear Pat,

Here is some network information and deal terms for the "Opportunity Florida" project. The "Opportunity Florida" ring will be fully protected with 2 nodes each having 1,000 Mbps of transport capacity. Each handoff will be Gig-E. These locations will be connected and backhauled to the closest Level 3 core router for Internet connectivity.

We will establish an Aggregate Committed Data Rate (ACDR) billing arrangement. This allows both locations to contribute to a single IP commitment. The ACDR commitment for this project is 200 Mbps with the ability to burst in aggregate of 2,000 Mbps. The total IRU price for IP is \$300,000. The price per megabit beyond the 200 Mbps ACDR is \$10/Mbps. This IP pricing will not change.

We are in the final stages of completing the Hard Cost Estimates (HCE) for the 2 node ring. The HCE's will be completed within the next 3-4 weeks. Although the pricing is still in a budgetary phase we feel that the final price should be within 10% of the proposed price. The current proposed IRU price is \$1,900,000.00. The approximate timeline for implementation is 120 days from the time Level 3 has a fully executed contract and receipt of funds.

The total budgetary estimate for 5 year IRU of Level 3: IP Services and Transport Connectivity equal \$2,200,000.00

Here is some network information and deal terms for the FHREDI project. The FHREDI ring will be fully protected with 3 nodes each having 1,000 Mbps of transport capacity. Each handoff will be Gig-E. These locations will be connected and backhauled to the closest Level 3 core router for Internet connectivity.

We will establish an Aggregate Committed Data Rate (ACDR) billing arrangement. This allows all 3 locations to contribute to a single IP commitment. The ACDR commitment for this project is 300 Mbps with the ability to burst in aggregate of 3,000 Mbps. The total IRU price for IP is \$450,000. The price per megabit beyond the 300 Mbps ACDR is \$10/Mbps. This IP pricing will not change.


We are in the final stages of completing the Hard Cost Estimates (HCE) for the 3 node ring. The HCE's will be completed within the next 3-4 weeks. Although the pricing is still in a budgetary phase we feel that the final price should be within 10% of the proposed price. The current proposed IRU price is \$2,850,000.00. The approximate timeline for implementation is 120 days from the time Level 3 has a fully executed contract and receipt of funds.



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## **MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT**

**THIS MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT** ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 19th day of March, 2010, by and between Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (hereinafter referred to as the "FRBA") and Government Services Group, Inc., a Florida corporation, whose business address is 1500 Mahan Drive, Suite 250, Tallahassee, Florida 32308 (hereinafter referred to as the "Manager").

### **WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the FRBA desires to obtain the professional management and planning services of the Manager to provide administration, management and consulting services to the FRBA; and

**WHEREAS**, the Manager represents that it has expertise in the type of professional services required by the FRBA;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the following mutual promises, covenants, provisions, representations, agreements and provisions, the parties hereto agree as follows:

**ARTICLE I**  
**DEFINITIONS AND CONSTRUCTION**

**SECTION 1.01 DEFINITIONS.** As used in this Agreement, the following terms shall have the following meanings unless the context hereof otherwise requires.

**"Additional Services"** means the administration, management and consulting services described in Sections 3.01 through 3.07 hereof.

**"Agreement"** means this Management Services Agreement, including any amendments and supplements hereto executed and delivered in accordance with the terms hereof.

**"Basic Services"** means the administration, management and consulting services described in Sections 2.01 through 2.07 hereof.

**"Billing Contractor"** means the firm or firms contracting with the FRBA to provide customer service and billing for the Systems.

**"Board"** shall mean the governing board of the FRBA.

**"Broadband"** shall mean two-way data transmission with advertised speeds of at least 768 kilobits per second (kbps) downstream and at least 200 kbps upstream to end users and providing sufficient capacity in a Middle Mile project to support the provision of broadband service to end users.

**"Financing Documents"** shall mean the resolution or resolutions duly adopted by the Board, as well as any loan agreement, indenture of trust, trust agreement or other instrument relating to the issuance or security of the obligations by the FRBA or any affiliated entity.

**"Fiscal Year"** means the period commencing on October 1 of each year and continuing through the next succeeding September 30, or such other period as may be prescribed by law as the fiscal year for the FRBA.

**"FRBA" or "Alliance"** means the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company formed through the regional cooperation of local and tribal governments, economic development agencies and community activists from rural disadvantaged communities located in 15 Florida counties designed to meet the essential and advanced broadband network needs of unserved and underserved communities in the Northwest Florida Rural Areas of Critical Economic Concern and the South Central Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (RACECs). These RACECs consist of Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty and Washington Counties in the Northwest Florida region and De Soto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands and Okeechobee Counties, as well as the unincorporated area of Immokalee in Collier County in the Southwest region of Florida.

**"Manager"** means Government Services Group, Inc., a Florida corporation.

**"Members"** means Florida's Heartland REDI, Inc. and the Northwest Florida Business Development Council, Inc. as the members of FRBA.

**"Operations Contractor"** means the firm or firms contracting with the FRBA to operate the Systems.

**"Service Providers"** means the last mile service providers who will access the Middle Mile systems of the Alliance to provide broadband infrastructure service to end users or end user devices.

**"Systems"** means the broadband and any other facilities owned, operated or managed by the FRBA during the term of this Agreement. As the term is used herein it shall also mean any broadband facilities or other system, separately accounted for and designated as such by the Board.

**SECTION 1.02 INTERPRETATION.** Words importing the singular number shall include the plural in each case and vice versa, and words importing persons shall include firms and corporations. The terms "herein," "hereunder," "hereby," "hereto," "hereof," and any similar terms, shall refer to this Agreement; the term "heretofore" shall mean before the effective date of this Agreement; and the term "hereafter" shall mean after the effective date of this Agreement. This Agreement shall not be construed more strongly against any party regardless that such party, or its counsel, drafted this Agreement.

**SECTION 1.03 SECTION HEADINGS.** Any headings preceding the texts of the several Articles and Sections of this Agreement and any table of contents or marginal notes appended to copies hereof, shall be solely for convenience of reference and shall neither constitute a part of this Agreement nor affect its meaning, construction or effect.

**ARTICLE II**  
**BASIC SERVICES**

**SECTION 2.01 BOARD MEETINGS.** The Manager will furnish the following administrative support to meetings of the Board:

- (A) provide timely notice of all regular and special Board meetings to the FRBA Board of Governors;
- (B) prepare and distribute an agenda to the FRBA Board for all Board meetings, including appropriate supporting documentation; and
- (C) maintain minutes and records of regular and special Board meetings.

**SECTION 2.02 GENERAL ADMINISTRATION.** The Manager will furnish the following general administrative support to the Board:

- (A) assist in identifying, selecting and contracting with system operations, rate consultants, auditors, insurance consultants, consulting engineers and other consultants or professionals required by the FRBA;
- (B) act as custodian of the FRBA's books and records consistent with best management practices and all applicable grant requirements;
- (C) serve as liaison between the Board, the local governments, economic development agencies, community, anchor institutions and other parties to which the FRBA provides broadband infrastructure facilities and/or services as follows: (1) coordinate service extensions; (2) communicate with local public officials and other parties on all matters that pertain to the FRBA; and (3) attend meetings, when requested, to discuss FRBA issues;
- (D) provide the Members and the Board, or individual members thereof, upon request, with data or information concerning the Systems and provide advice and recommendations on System operations to the Board and the Members;
- (E) develop and maintain accounting, budgeting and purchasing procedures;
- (F) negotiate leases, contracts, and other agreements, including consultant services, for the FRBA, subject to approval of the Board;
- (G) oversee and advise the FRBA on all local, state or federal filings identified to the Manager; and
- (H) monitor the performance of all terms and conditions in all leases, contracts, and agreements and notify the Board and the Members of any noted violation thereof.

**SECTION 2.03 ACCOUNTING.** The Manager will provide the following accounting services to the FRBA:

(A) The Manager will oversee the FRBA's accounting system and coordinate the systems billing function with the Billing Contractor to facilitate the management and investment of all cash in accordance with law, the Financing Documents, Board policy and generally accepted accounting principles.

(B) The Manager will require the Billing Contractor to provide a daily financial transactions report and a monthly financial report.

(C) The Manager will prepare statements of accounts payable, reconcile accounts receivable, maintain the general ledger, prepare monthly financial reports for the FRBA and coordinate with outside auditors in conducting an annual audit.

(D) Upon the request of the Members or any board member but not more often than monthly, the Manager will submit to the Board a statement of income and expenses for the FRBA Board together with a list of vouchers paid, if requested by the Board, and any financial matters requiring Board attention.

**SECTION 2.04 BUDGETS AND FINANCIAL REPORTS.** The Manager will provide the following budgeting and reporting services to the FRBA:

(A) On or before July 1 of each year, the Manager will prepare a proposed operating budget and capital improvement program for the ensuing Fiscal Year to be submitted to the Board for its review and approval.

(B) The Manager will prepare and file all financial reports required by the Financing Documents, Board policy and applicable law.

**SECTION 2.05 OTHER FINANCIAL SERVICES.** The Manager will provide the following additional financial services to the FRBA:

(A) The Manager will coordinate with the FRBA's rate consultant to develop rates when required that comply with the state and federal reporting requirements and any applicable Financing Documents.

(B) The Manager will coordinate with the FRBA's insurance consultant to insure the FRBA's assets in accordance with generally accepted industry practices.

**SECTION 2.06 OPERATIONAL OVERSIGHT.** The Manager will monitor the performance of the Operations Contractor and Billing Contractor, as follows:

(A) The Operations Contractor and Billing Contractor will be required to provide the reports as required in the Operations and Billing Agreement.

(B) The Manager will review the following issues with the Operations Contractor and Billing Contractor: (1) customer service, (2) operations and contract performance, (3) annual maintenance needs of

the Systems and (4) any unforeseen events that may affect the FRBA's agreement with the Operations Contractor or Billing Contractor.

- (C) Not later than April 1 of each year, the Manager shall compile and prepare:
  - (1) an annual report summarizing the performance of the operator;
  - (2) a status report of all capital projects; and
  - (3) an annual systems report which summarizes (a) work performed by the Operations Contractor and Billing Contractor, (b) other significant operations issues that have arisen during the preceding twelve months and (c) intergovernmental coordination issues.

The Manager shall secure any work orders necessary to complete the annual report and manage the activities of the consulting engineers and other vendors and professionals to ensure timely completion of the annual systems report.

**SECTION 2.07 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLANNING.**

(A) The Manager shall be responsible for coordinating the development of a capital improvement plan to facilitate compliance with applicable grant requirements and regulatory standards. In this regard, the Manager shall, not later than July 1, prepare an annual and six-year capital improvement program for facilities needed to repair, replace, enhance or provide additional service to FRBA's customers.

(B) The Manager shall provide review and approval for all proposed connections and extensions to the Systems. In this regard, the Manager shall (1) maintain an extension policy, (2) maintain standardized specifications for use on all Systems, and (3) provide standardized construction and professional service agreements for use on all Systems.

**SECTION 2.08 CAPITAL PROJECTS ADMINISTRATION SERVICES.** The Manager will perform the following capital projects administration services.

(A) Secure necessary work orders for design and supervision of construction of capital improvements, including repair and replacement activities, from the FRBA's consulting engineers and other professionals for Board approval, including:

- (1) The preparation of all bid specification documents by the engineers and other professionals;
- (2) Review of all responses, work orders and contracts from the respondents from a technical aspect;
- (3) Determination of the availability of funds and ensure consistency with programs and budgets; and

- (4) Ensure consistency with overall goals and objectives of the FRBA and the approval of the Board.

(B) Manage activities of the consulting engineer, and other professionals to facilitate timely completion and permitting of capital improvement facilities in the following manner:

- (1) The Manager will meet on an ongoing basis with the professionals selected by the FRBA to ensure that design concepts, construction standards, time frames and budgets are adhered to according to contract commitments.
- (2) The Manager will ensure that requirements necessary for the timely permitting of capital improvement facilities are coordinated and monitored.
- (3) Issues regarding acquisition of easements or right-of-way permits will be reviewed by the Manager and recommendations made to the Board concerning interests to be acquired.

(C) Coordinate new facility construction with activities of the Operations Contractor as follows:

- (1) The Manager will serve as liaison for coordination between the contract operators, customer service providers and the design and construction engineers responsible for these projects.
- (2) The Manager will meet on an ongoing basis with the engineers and the construction managers to provide an independent review of all design drawings and construction documents. For each project, an analysis will be conducted to determine potential for additional savings, to determine how to enhance continuing operations, to minimize maintenance costs, to resolve issues regarding design modifications and to ascertain the impact of those modifications on the budget and schedule.

(D) Ensure that recommendations for award of contracts for the construction of capital improvement facilities are in accordance with Florida law and FRBA policy and applicable grant requirements.

- (1) The Manager shall prepare the initial specifications for design of improvements. In addition, once design concepts have been developed, the Manager will oversee development of construction standards, procedures and documents. The Manager will work with the consulting engineers and other professionals to determine contract specifications, performance standards and budget. Each project will be reviewed and analyzed from the standpoint of inspection responsibility.

(E) As a part of project administration, the Manager will be involved in and assist in the resolution of conflicts relative to projects conducted by the FRBA. These disputes may include: contract issues, change orders, coordination with other systems or governmental entities and customer relations.

(F) The Manager will independently review project cost estimates.

(1) Due to the nature of these projects and the complexity of the agreements, independent cost estimates may be developed to ensure that the prices and fees being quoted by the contractors are reasonable.

(2) Pay request reviews and change order reviews will be performed by the Manager.

(G) The Manager will attend and participate in presentations required to assure the FRBA that projects are on schedule, and that appropriate information is being maintained to track and monitor such compliance. Presentations and meetings with local governmental entities or other interested parties to provide necessary information regarding the progress of these projects will be conducted as necessary.

**SECTION 2.09 GRANT COMPLIANCE.** Grant compliance and administration services shall include, but not be limited to: conducting environmental review(s), coordinating with the funding agency, developing and administering agency contract(s), representation during site visits and monitoring, developing project information management and filing system, developing project financial management system for receiving and disbursing funds, maintaining project account records, developing workplans for project contract documents, oversight of project schedule and grant compliance, requesting, tracking and managing program funds in compliance with program guidelines, providing all required federal reports and technical assistance, general observation of construction activities, field verification of quantities and adherence to project specifications, Davis-Bacon record-keeping requirements, review of change orders and pay requests for compliance with specifications and actual progress, bid/construction contract development support review bid documents and contract documents for compliance, oversight of citizen complaint process, monitoring all project vendors and/or subrecipients, supervision of payment authorizations, developing and processing amendments, as needed, reviewing change orders and amendments for compliance, as needed, providing regular project status reports to primary grantee, monitoring all project activity to ensure compliance, providing all other necessary technical assistance, reviewing final change order, paying request, and construction documents, balancing final project budget, gathering all necessary supporting documents, preparing documents for administrative/financial close out, preparing final status report.

**SECTION 2.10 COMPENSATION FOR BASIC SERVICES.**

(A) In consideration for the Basic Services described in Sections 2.01 through 2.07 of the Agreement, the FRBA agrees to pay the Manager a monthly fee of \$10,000.

Monthly fees for Basic Services described in Section 2.01 through 2.07 shall be payable at the end of each monthly period. In addition to the monthly fees for Basic Services, the FRBA shall reimburse the

Manager for its actual travel related expenses and costs of reproduction, postage, long distance telephone charges, conference call charges and express delivery incurred by the Manager in connection with the provision of Basic Services. Expenses related to Additional Services as described in Section 3.01 through 3.05 will be reimbursed on the same basis.

(B) The Manager shall be paid a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Administrative Fee to provide supervision, monitoring and financial management of the annual program of capital improvement projects as described in Section 2.08 hereof. This fee will be negotiable and subject to approval of a Work Order by the Board. The fee will be calculated based upon a percentage of the CIP projects (for example, 3% of construction costs). A work order will be submitted by the Manager and accepted by the FRBA Board prior to commencement of any work under this paragraph. Reproduction, postage, long distance telephone charges, conference call charges, delivery and travel expenses shall be reimbursed consistent with Basic Services.

(C) The Manager shall be paid a Grant Compliance Administrative Fee to provide supervision, monitoring and reporting of the grant compliance services as described in Section 2.09 hereof. This fee is based upon a percentage of the Grant award (for example, 2% of total construction portion of award). A Work Order will be submitted by the Manager and accepted by the FRBA Board and designed to effectively carry out these responsibilities. Reproduction, postage, long distance telephone charges, conference call charges, delivery and travel expenses shall be reimbursed consistent with Basic Services.

(D) Payment of the Manager's compensation hereunder shall be contingent on the availability of eligible funds for such operating expenses of the FRBA from grant funding or Systems revenues. Neither the members nor any entity represented on the Board shall be held responsible for payment of such compensation.

(E) Due to difficulty in predicting the impacts of growth and cost increases on the operations of the Systems, the method of compensation of the Manager shall be reviewed at the conclusion of the first 12 months of this Agreement. The General Counsel shall provide any recommended changes in the method or amount of compensation of the Manager to the Board for review and approval.

## **ARTICLE III ADDITIONAL SERVICES**

### **SECTION 3.01. SERVICE PROVIDER REVIEW.**

(A) Service provider review process will require the review and coordination with the Contract Operator, the request for service contracts for connections to the FRBA's assets and/or utilizations of services. In providing this review, the Manager, working in concert with the Contract Operator, will do the following:

- (1) Receive all service inquiries to determine their impact on capacity and ability to serve.
- (2) Provide letters of service availability, if applicable.
- (3) Outline the appropriate rates and tariffs to be charged for services.
- (4) Calculate back to the Board the financial impact on the system.

**SECTION 3.02. SERVICE PROVIDERS.** The parties acknowledge that it may be necessary to make service extensions or enter into service or improvement agreements with other service providers during the term of this Agreement. The Manager will be responsible for negotiating the terms of such agreements and making recommendations to the Board and the Members on matters relating to specific service extensions or agreements

**SECTION 3.03. SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS.** The parties acknowledge that the FRBA may desire to implement special assessment programs during the term of this Agreement to finance the installation, rehabilitation and maintenance of facilities. The Manager will prepare information necessary for development of the apportionment methodology, calculation of rates and the data processing and mechanical implementation required to collect special assessments on the ad valorem tax bill.

**SECTION 3.04. OPERATIONS AGREEMENT.** The parties acknowledge that the agreements between the FRBA and its Operations Contractor and Billing Contractor may expire during the term of this Agreement or authorized renewal periods. The Manager will be responsible for developing a request for proposals from Operations Contractors and Billing Contractors, evaluating the proposals received and making recommendations to the Board for selection.

**SECTION 3.05. CAPITAL PROJECT INSPECTION SERVICES.** The Manager shall be primarily responsible for onsite general construction inspection services for all capital projects and renewal and replacement projects. The Manager shall conduct necessary inspections and provide information collected and recorded to the engineer of record for preparation of record drawings and certification of construction as required by regulatory authorities. For each occasion where inspection services are required, the Manager shall submit to the Board for consideration a work authorization detailing the scope of services required and

the estimated costs for said services. Notwithstanding the foregoing requirement, for small repair or replacement projects funded under the Miscellaneous Renewal and Replacement budget, the Manager shall submit on an annual basis a work authorization for projected labor and associated costs related to inspection services for said projects. A report reflecting actual inspection hours incurred and payments made shall be submitted to the FRBA on a quarterly basis.

**SECTION 3.06. COMPENSATION FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES.**

(A) The Manager shall be responsible for submitting a written proposal to the FRBA specifying any Additional Services to be performed and the method of compensation therefore. The Agreement between the Manager and the FRBA shall be set forth in a Work Authorization for Additional Services or a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) that shall constitute a supplement to this Agreement and become binding upon the Manager and the FRBA. The Manager shall not be entitled to compensation for Additional Services provided without prior authorization from the Board.

(B) Additional Services may be provided on a negotiated lump sum professional fee or hourly basis. Whenever work is done on an hourly basis the following hourly rates will apply:

- (1) System Administrator \$200/hour;
- (2) Director of Operations \$182/hour;
- (3) VP-Project Consultant \$175/hour;
- (4) Senior Management \$171/hour;
- (5) Senior Consultant \$140/hour;
- (6) Project Manager \$130/hour;
- (7) Consultant \$125/hour;
- (8) Technical Support \$114/hour;
- (9) Clerk \$ 85/hour;
- (10) Administrative support \$ 47/hour.

**ARTICLE IV**  
**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**SECTION 4.01. FRBA RESPONSIBILITIES.**

(A) The Board shall timely transmit instructions, receive information, interpret and define FRBA policies and provide policy direction on decisions with respect to Manager's services for a project.

(B) The Board shall:

- (1) Review and make appropriate recommendations on all requests submitted by the Manager for payment for services and work provided and performed in accordance with this Agreement;
- (2) Provide all criteria and information requested by Manager as to FRBA requirements for any Basic Services or Additional Services, including interlocal matters, policy and policy direction;
- (3) Upon request from Manager, assist Manager by placing at Manager's disposal all information available to the FRBA;
- (4) Arrange for access to and make all provisions for Manager to enter the FRBA facilities to perform the services to be provided by Manager under this Agreement;
- (5) Appropriately direct and delegate management oversight to the Manager concerning all contracts and relations of the FRBA. For all such purposes Manager is hereby and shall hereafter be deemed the "FRBA Representative" or "FRBA General Manager" as such terms may be defined elsewhere, including the Financing Documents.
- (6) Provide notice to Manager of any deficiencies or defects discovered by the FRBA with respect to the services to be rendered by the Manager hereunder as well as all notices received or provided under any operations, billing, financing, acquisition or other agreements entered into which in any way affect or pertain to the Systems.

**SECTION 4.02. TERM OF AGREEMENT.** This Agreement shall be for a term commencing on the date first above written and ending on September 30, 2015. However, the term hereof may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties. Upon any renewal the parties agree that the monthly fee for Basic Services and the applicable hourly rates for Additional Services will be subject to an adjustment based on the increase in the Consumer Price Index, the expansion of the Systems and the most current hourly rates of the Manager.

**SECTION 4.03. INSURANCE.**

(A) During the term of this Agreement, the Manager shall provide, pay for and maintain, with companies satisfactory to the FRBA, the types of insurance described herein. All insurance shall be from responsible companies duly authorized to do business in the State of Florida and/or responsible risk retention group insurance companies registered with the State of Florida. The insurance coverages and limits required must be evidenced by properly executed certificates of insurance on forms, which are acceptable to the FRBA. The certificates must be personally, manually signed by the authorized representatives of the insurance company/companies shown on the certificates with proof that he/she is an authorized representative thereof. In addition, certified, true and exact copies of all insurance policies required shall be provided to the FRBA, on a timely basis, if required by the FRBA. These certificates and policies shall contain provisions that thirty days' written notice by registered or certified mail shall be given the FRBA of any cancellation, intent not to renew or reduction in the policies' coverages, except in the application of the aggregate limits provisions. In the event of a reduction in the aggregate limit of any policy, the Manager shall immediately take steps to have the aggregate limit reinstated to the full extent permitted under such policy. The acceptance by the FRBA of any certificate of insurance evidencing the insurance coverages and limits required in this Agreement does not constitute approval or agreement by the FRBA that the insurance requirements have been met or that the insurance policies shown on the certificates of insurance are in compliance with the requirements of this Agreement.

(B) All liability insurance policies, other than the Professional Liability, Worker's Compensation and Employers' Liability policies, obtained by Manager to meet the requirements of this Agreement shall name FRBA as an additional insured as to the operations of the Manager under this Agreement and shall contain severability of interests provisions.

(C) Commercial General Liability Insurance shall be maintained to cover liability for bodily injury and property damage. Exposures to be covered are: premises, operations, products/completed operations and contractual. Coverage must be written on an occurrence basis, with no less than the following limits of liability:

- (1) Single Limit Bodily Injury & Property Damage
  - (a) Each Occurrence \$ 500,000
  - (b) Annual Aggregate 1,000,000
- (2) Personal Injury (Annual Aggregate) \$1,000,000

(D) Comprehensive Automobile Liability shall be maintained for all vehicles in the performance of this Agreement:

- (1) Single Limit Bodily Injury & Property Damage (Each Occurrence) C \$1,000,000

(2) Coverage shall include owned, hired and/or non owned vehicles. The FRBA must be named as an additional insured for the Automobile and Commercial General Liability coverage.

(E) Professional Liability shall be maintained with limits not less than \$2,000,000. If coverage is provided on a claims made basis then coverage must be continued for the duration of this Agreement and for not less than one year thereafter, or in lieu of continuation, provide an "extended reporting clause" for one year.

(F) Workers' Compensation Insurance shall be maintained during the life of this Agreement to comply with statutory limits for all employees, and in the case any work is subcontracted, the Manager shall require any subcontractors similarly to provide Workers' Compensation Insurance for all the latter's employees unless such employees are covered by the protection afforded by the Manager. The Manager and his subcontractors shall maintain during the life of this Agreement Employer's Liability Insurance. The following must be maintained:

(1) Workers' Compensation – Statutory

(2) Employer's Liability – \$100,000 per accident

(G) If any insurance provided pursuant to this Agreement expires during the term hereof, renewal certificates of insurance and, if requested by FRBA, certified, true copies of the renewal policies shall be furnished by Manager thirty days prior to the date of expiration.

**SECTION 4.04. INDEMNIFICATION.** The Consultant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Alliance, its officers, agents and employees against any loss, damage or expense (including all costs and reasonable attorneys' fees) suffered by the Alliance from any claim, demand, judgment, decree or cause of action of any kind or nature arising out of any negligent error, omission or act of the Manager, its agents, servants or employees in the performance of services under this Contract.

**SECTION 4.05 DEFAULT AND TERMINATION.** Either party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon 180 calendar days' written notice to the other party. The Manager shall be entitled to payment for professional fees earned and reimbursable costs incurred prior to the date of such termination.

**SECTION 4.06 DISCLOSURE.**

(A) The FRBA Board and the Members are familiar with and have been fully apprised that the Manager also provides services to numerous governmental entities and other clients throughout Florida, including but not limited to, counties and municipalities which are, or could become members of the FRBA. The FRBA enters into this Agreement after consultation and consideration of the unique circumstances surrounding the creation and formation of the FRBA.

(B) Subject only to the foregoing disclosure and consent, Manager represents that it presently has no interest and shall acquire no interest, either direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner with the performance of services required hereunder. Manager further represents that no persons having such interest shall be employed to perform those services.

**SECTION 4.07 GENERAL COUNSEL APPROVAL REQUIRED.** This Agreement, although executed by the FRBA and the Manager, shall not become a binding contract between the parties unless and until the FRBA General Counsel has reviewed and approved the Agreement. Should the Manager, at the request of the Board, render services contemplated by this Agreement prior to approval of the Agreement by the General Counsel, the FRBA shall compensate the Manager for said services rendered and expenses as contemplated by this Agreement, but no other requirements or conditions of the Agreement shall apply unless and until the General Counsel approves the Agreement.

**SECTION 4.08 ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the parties pertaining to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior, other and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, negotiations and discussions of the parties, whether oral or written, and there are no warranties, representations or other agreements between the parties in connection with the subject matter hereof, except as specifically set forth herein.

**SECTION 4.9 AMENDMENTS AND WAIVERS.** No amendment, supplement, modification or waiver of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by all parties hereto. No waiver of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed or shall constitute a waiver of any other provision of this Agreement, whether or not similar, unless otherwise expressly provided.

**SECTION 4.10 NOTICES.** All notices, certificates or other communications hereunder shall be sufficiently given and shall be deemed given when hand delivered or mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, to the parties at the following addresses:

**SECTION 4.11 ASSIGNMENT AND BINDING EFFECT.** This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other party. To the extent provided herein, this Agreement shall be binding upon the parties, their respective successors and assigns and shall inure to the benefit of the parties, their respective successors and assigns.




**SECTION 4.14 APPLICABLE LAW.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.



## **AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL COUNSEL SERVICES**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into this 19th of March, 2010 by and between the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (hereinafter referred to as the "FRBA") and Nabors, Giblin & Nickerson, P.A. whose business address is 1500 Mahan Drive, Suite 200, Tallahassee, Florida 32308 (hereinafter referred to as the "General Counsel").

### **WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the FRBA desires to obtain the professional services of the General Counsel to provide general legal services to aid in conducting the business of the FRBA; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Counsel represents that it has expertise in the type of professional services that will be required by the FRBA.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the following mutual premises, covenants, provisions, representations, agreements and provisions, the parties hereto agree as follows:

## ARTICLE I

### GENERAL COUNSEL SERVICES

**SECTION 1.01. DEFINITIONS.** As used in this Agreement, the following terms shall have the following meanings unless the context hereof otherwise requires.

**"Additional Services"** means the legal services described in Sections 2.01 and 2.02 hereof.

**"Agreement"** means this Agreement for General Counsel services, including any amendments and supplements hereto executed and delivered in accordance with the terms hereof.

**"Alliance Facilities"** means the FRBA's broadband distribution facilities and property, including Middle Mile and Last Mile infrastructure facilities, as they may be modified, improved or expanded from time to time, which are owned, leased, operated, managed and/or used, from time to time, by the FRBA. Alliance Facilities shall include all property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, now or hereafter owned, leased, operated or managed by the FRBA in connection with the provision of broadband facilities and services.

**"Articles of Organization"** means the Articles of Organization of the FRBA filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, creating the FRBA and establishing the Board and its duties, as may be amended from time to time.

**"Basic Services"** means the legal services described in Sections 1.02 and 1.03 hereof.

**"Billing Contractor"** means the firm contracting with the FRBA to provide customer service and utility billing for the Alliance Facilities.

"Board" shall mean the Board of Governors of the FRBA.

"Financing Documents" shall mean the resolution or resolutions duly adopted by the Board, as well as any loan agreement, indenture of trust, trust agreement or other instrument relating to any financing, the issuance of bonds or other certificate of indebtedness by the FRBA or any affiliated entities thereof.

"Fiscal Year" means the period commencing on October of each year and continuing through the next succeeding September 30, or such other period as may be prescribed by law as the fiscal year for the FRBA.

"General Manager" means Government Services Group, Inc., a Florida corporation or its successor under contract with the FRBA.

"FRBA" or "Alliance" means the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company.

"Members" means, initially, Florida's Heartland REDI, Inc. and Northwest Florida Business Development Council, Inc., as the members of the FRBA pursuant to the Articles of Organization.

"Operations Contractor" means the firm contracting with the FRBA to operate and maintain the Alliance Facilities.

**SECTION 1.02. BOARD MEETINGS.** General Counsel shall provide to the FRBA the following General Counsel services and legal advice to support the Board at its meetings:

- (A) review all agenda materials in advance and where necessary provide comment and advice as to form and legality;
- (B) attend all Board meetings upon reasonable notice;

(C) be available to provide advice, conduct legal research and render opinions on legal issues raised by the Board and the Members and relating to the construction and operation of the Alliance Facilities; and

(D) provide independent review and advice to the Board and the Members of the performance of the contractual duties and responsibilities of the General Manager, the Billing Contractor, the Operations Contractor and other entities and firms under contract with the FRBA.

**SECTION 1.03. GENERAL COUNSEL.** The General Counsel will provide to the FRBA and its General Manager the following General Counsel services:

(A) provide general advice and legal research on the powers and authority of the FRBA under the Articles of Organization and Florida law;

(B) draft and review resolutions, agreements or other documentation required by the FRBA, the Board or the Members in the performance of their duties under the Articles of Organization and Florida law;

(C) advice and research on the feasibility and legal sufficiency of actual or potential real property transactions;

(D) assistance in the defense or prosecution of litigation;

(E) advice and research on the feasibility and legal sufficiency of potential debt financing concepts and structure;

(F) advice and research on the feasibility and legal sufficiency of funding alternatives, fees and charges

(G) advice and research on construction, operation and maintenance of the Alliance Facilities under State and federal law; and

(H) be available to provide Additional Services as directed by the Board or the General Manager.

**SECTION 1.04. COMPENSATION FOR GENERAL COUNSEL SERVICES.**

(A) In consideration of the first twelve (12) hours of General Counsel services to be provided pursuant to Sections 1.02 and 1.03 during each monthly period, the FRBA agrees to pay the General Counsel a fee of \$1,800.00 payable at the end of each monthly period. Attorney time incurred in excess of twelve (12) hours during each monthly period shall be compensated at the hourly rates specified in Appendix A.

(B) Compensation shall be paid at one-half (1/2) the hourly rate specified in Appendix A for the hours incurred in travel from the host office of the attorney performing legal services to the location where services are required to be provided.

(C) Payment of General Counsel's compensation hereunder shall be contingent on the availability of eligible funds for such operating expenses of the FRBA from grant funding or revenues of the Alliance Facilities. Neither the Members nor the entities represented on the Board shall be responsible for payment of General Counsel's compensation hereunder.

## **ARTICLE II**

### **ADDITIONAL SERVICES**

**SECTION 2.01. FUTURE FRBA ACQUISITIONS.** The parties acknowledge that the FRBA may acquire additional Alliance Facilities or divest itself of acquired Alliance Facilities during the term of this Agreement. The General Counsel may be asked to evaluate information developed by the FRBA's rate consultants, consulting engineers, and other professionals, for each proposed acquisition or divestiture and make recommendations to the Board and the Members. Additionally, in connection with the issuance of any financing, bonds or certificates of indebtedness by the FRBA or any affiliated entity to acquire or improve Alliance Facilities, the General Counsel shall provide an opinion as to the power and authority of the FRBA and the regularity of its proceedings as reasonably requested by its lender, bond counsel or any underwriter.

**SECTION 2.02. OTHER ADDITIONAL SERVICES.** The Board or the General Manager may request the General Counsel to perform other legal services, and to research or prepare legal opinions beyond the scope of the services called for in Sections 1.02 and 1.03 of this Agreement. Such services shall be deemed Additional Services.

#### **SECTION 2.03. COMPENSATION AND AUTHORIZATION.**

(A) At the request of the General Manager or the Board, prior to commencement, submit an estimate of the anticipated cost of any proposed Additional Services for approval.

(B) Compensation for the General Counsel services contemplated in Sections 2.01 and 2.02 shall be provided on an hourly basis at the hourly rate specified in

Appendix A unless such services are approved by the General Manager or the Board to be provided on a lump sum basis. All such legal services shall be authorized by the General Manager or the Board.

**SECTION 2.04. REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS.** In addition to the legal fees or other compensation provided in this Agreement, General Counsel shall be reimbursed for costs incurred on long distance telephone charges, travel expenses, overnight delivery charges and photocopies. Any travel expenses shall be reimbursed in accordance with section 112.061, Florida Statutes.

## ARTICLE III

### GENERAL PROVISIONS

**SECTION 3.01. TERM OF AGREEMENT.** This Agreement shall be for a term commencing on March 1, 2010, and ending on September 30, 2012. However, the term hereof may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties for successive 24 month periods.

**SECTION 3.02. QUALIFIED PROFESSIONALS REQUIRED.** The General Counsel services to be provided hereunder relate to legal services which require that all professionals assigned to assist the FRBA be members of the Florida Bar in good standing.

**SECTION 3.03. INSURANCE.**

(A) During the term of this Agreement, the General Counsel shall provide, pay for, and maintain, with a company satisfactory to the FRBA, the professional liability insurance described herein. Such insurance shall be from a responsible company duly authorized to do business in the State of Florida or responsible risk retention group insurance companies registered with the State of Florida. The insurance coverage and limit required must be evidenced by a properly executed certificate of insurance on a form which is acceptable to the FRBA. The certificate must be personally, manually signed by the authorized representatives of the insurance company shown on the certificate with proof that the representative is an authorized representative. In addition, certified, true and exact copies of the insurance policy required shall be provided to the FRBA, on a timely basis, if required by the FRBA. The certificate and policy shall contain a provision that thirty days written notice by registered or certified mail shall be

given the FRBA of any cancellation, intent not to renew, or reduction in the policy's coverage, except in the application of the aggregate limits provisions. In the event of a reduction in the aggregate limit of the policy, the General Counsel shall immediately take steps to have the aggregate limit reinstated to the full extent permitted under such policy. The acceptance by the FRBA of any certificate of insurance evidencing the insurance coverage and limits required in this Agreement does not constitute approval or agreement by the FRBA that the insurance requirements have been met or that the insurance policy shown on the certificate of insurance is in compliance with the requirements of this Agreement.

(B) Professional Liability insurance shall be maintained with limits not less than \$2,000,000. If coverage is provided on a claims made basis then coverage must be continued for the duration of this Agreement and for not less than one year thereafter, or in lieu of continuation, provide an "extended reporting clause" for one year.

(C) If any insurance provided pursuant to this Agreement expires during the term hereof, a renewal certificate of insurance and, if requested by FRBA, a certified, true copy of the renewal policy shall be furnished by General Counsel thirty days prior to the date of expiration.

**SECTION 3.04. SUBCONTRACTORS.** The services to be performed hereunder shall be performed by General Counsel, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the FRBA, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. The employment of, contract with, or use of the services of any other person or firm by General Counsel, as independent contractor or otherwise, shall be subject to the prior written approval of the

FRBA. No provision of this Agreement shall, however, be construed as constituting an agreement between the FRBA and any such other person or firm. Nor shall anything contained herein be deemed to give any such party or any third party any claim or right of action against the FRBA beyond such as may otherwise exist without regard to this Agreement.

**SECTION 3.05. DEFAULT AND TERMINATION.** The General Counsel serves at the pleasure of the Board. The General Counsel shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon 60 calendar days written notice to the FRBA. The General Counsel shall be entitled to payment for professional fees earned and reimbursable costs incurred prior to the date of such termination.

**SECTION 3.06. DISCLOSURE.** General Counsel represents that it presently has no interest and shall acquire no interest, either direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner with the performance of services required hereunder.

**SECTION 3.07. ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the parties pertaining to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior other and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, negotiations and discussions of the parties, whether oral or written, and there are no warranties, representations or other agreements between the parties in connection with the subject matter hereof, except as specifically set forth herein.

**SECTION 3.08. AMENDMENTS AND WAIVERS.** No amendment, supplement, modification or waiver of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by all parties hereto. No waiver of any of the provisions of this Agreement

shall be deemed or shall constitute a waiver of any other provision of this Agreement, whether or not similar, unless otherwise expressly provided.

**SECTION 3.09. NOTICES.** All notices, certificates or other communications hereunder shall be sufficiently given and shall be deemed given when hand delivered or mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, to the parties at the following address:





**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN**

**FLORIDA RURAL BROADBAND ALLIANCE, LLC**

**AND**

**HARDEE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

This document constitutes Memorandum of Understanding between the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company ("FRBA") and Hardee County Industrial Development Authority, a public body corporate and politic existing under the laws of the State of Florida (ss.159.44-159.53) ("IDA").

FRBA was founded for the purpose of creating a coalition of Florida's rural and economically disadvantaged communities located throughout 15 counties to act as the Applicant for a BTOP Round 2 Application for federal broadband stimulus funding. The FRBA application will request federal assistance to construct a broadband middle mile infrastructure network to serve the Northwest Florida Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (NWRACEC) consisting of Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty and Washington Counties and the South Central Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (SCRACEC) consisting of DeSoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands and Okeechobee Counties as well as the unincorporated area of Immokalee in Collier County.

On November 12, 2009, Rapid Systems, Inc. ("Rapid") and the IDA filed a joint application with the Hardee County Economic Development Authority for a grant to fund the construction and maintenance of broadband infrastructure and related equipment and services to serve Hardee County, Florida and the operation of affordable broadband services to residences, businesses and anchor institutions in Hardee County, Florida (the "Project") for an initial period of three (3) years. The Hardee County Application proposed a grant of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) with a matching investment by Rapid of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in cash, equipment and in-kind services, for a total Project amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00).

For the SCRACEC region, FRBA has established a strategic partnership with Rapid and the IDA in order to enhance the "shovel ready" nature of the project. Pursuant to the proposed partnership, the IDA will make an in kind contribution to FRBA of an indefeasible right of use of the completed Hardee County network, including the commitment of Rapid's matching investment of cash, equipment and in-kind services in order to assist in reaching the 30% matching requirement for the BTOP grant. In recognition of the value of the IDA's contribution, FRBA will contract with third party providers for backbone capacity for the entire SCRACEC, including Hardee County, for an initial five year term. Further, the partnership between FRBA

and the IDA will be employed to facilitate the location of a data center within Hardee County. As part of FRBA's business development efforts, FRBA will cooperate with the IDA to attract data center clients to the SCRACEC region. Since the Hardee network will be deployed in advance of the remainder of the SCRACEC region, FRBA's business development will focus on Hardee County as a logical location for any proposed data center clients.

The IDA will benefit from the award of a grant to FRBA in that upstream capacity will be contracted by FRBA on a wholesale basis for the entire SCRACEC representing a substantial savings to the IDA. Further, the FRBA network for the entire SCRACEC will be designed and deployed consistent with the architecture of the Hardee County network promoting consistency of service availability throughout the region. Finally, the IDA will benefit from the business development partnership with FRBA through enhanced opportunities to attract new businesses such as data center clients. FRBA will benefit from its partnership with the IDA by expediting deployment of its middle mile facilities through its use of the infrastructure of the completed Hardee County network.





**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN****FLORIDA RURAL BROADBAND ALLIANCE, LLC****AND****RAPID SYSTEMS, INC.**

This document constitutes Memorandum of Understanding between the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company ("FRBA") and Rapid Systems, Inc., a Florida corporation ("Rapid").

FRBA was founded for the purpose of creating a coalition of Florida's rural and economically disadvantaged communities located throughout 15 counties to act as the Applicant for a BTOP Round 2 Application for federal broadband stimulus funding. The FRBA application will request federal assistance to construct a broadband middle mile infrastructure network to serve the Northwest Florida Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (NWRACEC) consisting of Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty, and Washington Counties and the South Central Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (SCRACEC) consisting of DeSoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands and Okeechobee Counties as well as the unincorporated area of Immokalee in Collier County.

Rapid is a private corporation that deploys and operates wireless broadband middle mile and last mile networks in the state of Florida. On November 12, 2009, Rapid and the Hardee County Industrial Development Authority ("IDA") filed a joint application with the Hardee County Economic Development Authority ("EDA") for a grant to fund the construction and maintenance of broadband infrastructure and related equipment and services to serve Hardee County, Florida and the operation of affordable broadband services to residences, businesses and anchor institutions in Hardee County, Florida (the "Project") for an initial period of three (3) years. The Hardee County Application proposed a grant of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) with a matching investment by Rapid of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in cash, equipment and in-kind services, for a total Project amount of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00). The EDA approved the Project and design, construction and deployment are underway.

For the SCRACEC region, FRBA has established a strategic partnership with Rapid and the IDA in order to enhance the "shovel ready" nature of the project. Pursuant to the proposed partnership, the IDA will make an in-kind contribution to FRBA of an indefeasible right of use of the completed Hardee County network, including the commitment of Rapid's matching investment of cash, equipment and in-kind services in order to assist in reaching the matching requirement for the BTOP grant. Further, Rapid will be engaged by FRBA to deploy and operate

the FRBA middle mile network in the SCRACEC. Finally, Rapid will be referenced in the FRBA application as a key component in satisfying the last mile coverage requirement as a provider of last mile service throughout the SCRACEC.

Rapid will benefit from the award of a grant to FRBA in that Rapid will be contracted to construct and operate the middle mile infrastructure in the SCRACEC region and through expanded opportunities to provide last mile service within the region. FRBA will benefit from its partnership with Rapid by expediting deployment of its middle mile facilities and by making it possible for residents, businesses and community anchor institutions throughout the SCRACEC to obtain affordable last mile service as soon as possible.

The parties agree to jointly participate in submission of the BTOP Round 2 grant application, including planning and preliminary design of the middle mile network and creation of a business model for deployment and operations in the SCRACEC. The parties recognize that their cooperation and coordination in this effort will enhance FRBA's grant application and the ability to extend broadband infrastructure throughout the SCRACEC.



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN**

This document constitutes Memorandum of Understanding between the Florida Rural Broadband Alliance, LLC, a Florida limited liability company ("FRBA") and Xicom Wireless, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Xicom").

FRBA was founded for the purpose of creating a coalition of Florida's rural and economically disadvantaged communities located throughout 15 counties to act as the Applicant for a BTOP Round 2 Application for federal broadband stimulus funding. The FRBA application will request federal assistance to construct a broadband middle mile infrastructure network to serve the Northwest Florida Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (NWRACEC) consisting of Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty, and Washington Counties and the South Central Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (SCRACEC) consisting of DeSoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands and Okeechobee Counties as well as the unincorporated area of Immokalee in Collier County.

Xicom is a private corporation that designs, deploys and operates wireless broadband middle mile networks. Further, Xicom's subsidiary, Main Street Broadband, deploys and operates last mile networks for retail, residential and business services.

For the NWRACEC region, FRBA has established a strategic partnership with Xicom in order to enhance the "shovel ready" nature of the project. Xicom will be engaged to complete the final design, deploy and then operate the FRBA middle mile network in the NWRACEC. In addition, Xicom is prepared to make a cash contribution to the FRBA project to assist in meeting the 30% match requirement for the BTOP program. Xicom has proposed a cash contribution of up to \$6 million for the FRBA project to aid in the extension of broadband middle mile infrastructure in the Florida panhandle region.

The amount of the final cash contribution from Xicom will be determined after the value of all in-kind donations from the counties and cities benefitting from deployment of the network are validated during the due diligence process required for award of a BTOP grant.

Xicom will benefit from the award of a grant to FRBA in that Xicom will be contracted to construct and operate the middle mile infrastructure in the panhandle region and through expanded opportunities for Main Street Broadband to provide last mile service within the region. FRBA will benefit from its partnership with Xicom by expediting deployment of its




