Deployment was performed from Hardy's own funds due to delay in resolution of co-first security interest requirement and NTIA requirement for environmental assessment (see #3).

NTIA confirmation of co-first priority security interest between NTIA and existing lenders, as previously discussed. Reclassification of Line Item Budget items, as previously discussed. Hardy Telecommunications has also received a BIP award from RUS, performance of which is dependent in part upon performance of the BTOP award. RUS has granted categorical exclusions to NEPA and does not require an EA. RUS will allow non-ground disturbing or land clearing activities to begin immediately upon release of BIP funds. BTOP has not granted categorical exclusions to NEPA and does require an EA, preventing construction before obtaining a FONSI. If NTIA and RUS could coordinate on NEPA categorical exclusions, Hardy could begin aerial deployment on existing poles in previously disturbed ROWs.
