In addition, inconsistent instructions and/or changes/clarification on required forms for reporting has used internal resources that typically would be used to process rights of way, obtain permits etc. We need the ability to make decisions on our own or have National Telecommunications and Information Administration respond in a more timely fashion (i.e.: Fiber Strand Miles in the Annual Performance Progress Reports).
