The Connect Arkansas Mapping Team has brought the Interactive Broadband Map for Arkansas in house. Previously Gadberry Group, LLC, hosted the Interactive Map, but the move to bring the Map in house allows for greater flexibility, more control over design, and primarily a better outlook in regards to sustainability. The new interactive map will be online in the first week of February. To facilitate this move, the mapping team is making use of an Amazon EC2 Windows Server instance for maximum availability as well as a license of ESRI ArcServer to manage and serve the data as the users interact with the map. The extended flexibility will allow us to display more items in the future such as Community Anchor Information, Wireless Connectivity Points, and other Demographics that are pertinent to Broadband users in the state of Arkansas.

ESRI Internet Usage Survey Data was purchased to be used alongside the MicroBuild Broadband Indicator data obtained from the Gadberry Group, LLC that was purchased in the Q4 2010 quarterly report. Since then Demographic data from data warehouse ACXIOM has been purchased to take an analytical approach to predictive modeling of broadband subscription. We are working with the University of Central Arkansas Math Department to take this approach.

During this quarter, Data from Fall 2011 was collected from Broadband Providers and submitted to NTIA prior to October 1 deadline. Coverage areas in censusblocks greater than 2 square miles was shown in address point format in areas where address points have

been collected. Also Connect Arkansas hired temporary phone bank workers to attempt to add further data to the Community Anchor data set. Comments on the Fall Submission from Andrew MacRae (NTIA) were reviewed and addressed by mapping team. 10bb. Please describe any challenge or obstacle that you have encountered and detail the mitigation strategies the project team is employing Preparing for reporting data in Census 2010 data for providers that submit data in 2000 format is challenging due to the fact that the census blocks do not match one to one, or even one to many. Several Providers attempted to convert to 2010 prior to submitting data. however many issues were found with these data sets and Connect Arkansas used previous information submitted as well as local knowledge of coverage areas to fill in gaps. We foresee this being an issue going forward with several providers until the providers make the change to 2010 data. Also hardware/software issues have become a problem with our wireless drive testing. These problems are minor but have been and nuisance to the verification process. We plan to resolve this by improving the quality of the laptop and or other equipment being used for verification.

Please provide any other information that you think would be useful to NTIA as it assesses your Broadband Mapping Project Several Providers have mentioned they are experiencing "survey fatigue", from having to provide different sets of data to different groups i.e. form 477 coverage data to FCC, coverage data as requested by the NOFA to Connect Arkansas, etc. These providers have expressed a reluctance to submit any additional data than what is required in the NOFA or NOFA Clarification on the basis of the man hours exerted to collect and process more information to provide to our Data Collection effort.
