While South Carolina is beginning to recover from the economic downturn of the past few years, the technical colleges have not seen an increase in funding; therefore making it difficult for them to keep current with today's technology. With the help of the Broadband Technology Opportunities Program-PCC Grant stimulus funding, the 16 technical colleges have been able to provide internet access to the most rural areas of the state which otherwise would not have had broadband access.

Now that the majority of the PCCs have been establish or improved, the focus has moved to training. There has been a wide variety of training classes and workshops offered to the community. Training classes/workshop range from basic computer skills classes, GED refresher courses, and classes on how to better budget your money. The availability of PCCs promote economic recovery by offering training to the citizens of South Carolina, in turn creating participants who will be more marketable in the job market.
