REASON(S) FOR AMENDMENT ADCOM911 is requesting that NTIA lift the suspension of funds and activities related to the LTE portion of our grant which were suspended on May 10th 2012. Since that time ADCOM911 has continued work towards completing the Broadband portion of our project, allowed outside of the terms of the partial suspension. Concurrently ADCOM911 conducted negotiations with FirstNet, which allow ADCOM911 use of the 700MHz LTE spectrum. On November 15th 2013 ADCOM911 and FirstNet concluded these negotiations on the SMLA which allows ADCOM911 the use of the 700MHz LTE spectrum. On January 22nd 2014 the SMLA was fully executed by both parties. On January 22, 2014, a Spectrum Manager Lease Agreement with the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) authorized the recipient to utilize the 700 MHz public safety broadband spectrum necessary for deployment and operation of the grant-funded network. With that in mind, ADCOM911 is confident that we can complete the project, and have a functional LTE network operating by the end of the grant term, Dec. 31st 2014.				
This Amendment approved by the Grants Officer is issued in triplicate and constitute an obligation of Federal funding. By signing the three documents, the Recipient agrees to comply with the Amendment provisions checked below and attached, as well as previous provisions incorporated into the Award. Upon acceptance by the Recipient, two signed Amendment documents shall be returned to the Grants Officer and the third document shall be retained by the Recipient.
