6. Funding Clause:

The award period and budget(s) incorporated into this award cover a five (5) year period and the budget sets forth a total Federal cost of \$4,318,733.00 in Federal funds. However, Federal funding approved and available at this time is limited to \$1,843,760 for the Recipient's broadband mapping activities and \$500,000 for broadband planning activities, for a total amount of \$2,343,760. The overall award period for this action will extend from October 1, 2009 through October 1, 2014. The funding period for this phase will extend from October 1, 2009 through October 1, 2011 for broadband mapping activities and October 1, 2009 through October 1, 2013 for broadband planning activities. Receipt of any future funding will be contingent upon program priorities resulting from the outcome of the Department of Commerce's analysis of the overall program, satisfactory performance and the availability of funds from Congress. Future funding will be at the sole discretion of the Department of Commerce.
