
This grant is hereby amended to revise and update the contact information for the Federal program officer for special award condition #3 and incorporate special award condition #22-Program Income.

22. Program Income

On December 17, 2010, NTIA waived the limitation on the use of program income set forth in Section V.E. of the Notice of Funds Availability [74 Fed.
