## AWARD ACTION REQUEST NO-COST EXTENSION

Please accept this letter formally requesting a No-Cost Extension through July 31, 2020, to allow LA-RICS Authority to complete orders for equipment as well as complete entitlement work for sites 21-26 with closeout materials including invoices and claims for reimbursement to be submitted to the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) by no later than August 15, 2020, as directed.

Per discussions with your office this letter requests approval of certain activities that could complete by the August 15, 2020, close-out documentation submission deadline included in the Special Award Condition (SAC) Amendment No. 29. The balance of work will be completed by AT&T/FirstNet (Enclosure). In order to successfully incorporate these sites into the National Public Safety Broadband Network (NPSBN) and fulfill the objectives of the Broadband Technologies Opportunities Program (BTOP) we request the following:

### EQUIPMENT ORDER

In order to successfully achieve completion of activities and closeout submission to grantor by August 15, 2020, and eliminate any stranded equipment, the LA-RICS Authority requests NTIA and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) approval of grant reimbursement for equipment ordered that could not be cancelled for use at sites listed below. This equipment was appropriately ordered and expected to deploy at sites within the performance period of the BTOP grant prior to COVID 19 shutdown. The equipment will be used/reordered and utilized at the sites listed below and completed by AT&T. For the equipment that was cancelled/returned, AT&T and the LA-RICS Authority will re-order/source the needed equipment and ensure receipt in time for the closeout of grant-funded work by August 15, 2020, as directed.

SITE ACCESS, PERMITTING AND ZONING

In order to successfully achieve completion of activities and closeout submission to grantor by August 15, 2020, as directed, the LA-RICS Authority requests NTIA/NOAAs funding approval of completion of site access, permit and zoning requirements needed to achieve construction of the sites listed in Table 2. The minimal costs associated with the remaining site access activities are also listed below. Completion of this work will ensure these sites form part of the NPSBN with AT&Ts commitment to complete construction for the same and LA-RICS' commitment to complete entitlement activities by July 31, 2020. Both the Authority and AT&T agree that it will be significantly harder if AT&T is forced to start the entitlement process anew and could render the site too difficult to build.

On behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of AT&T Inc. (AT&T), I ask you to accept this letter in support of the Los Angeles Regional Interoperable Communications System Authority's (LA-RICS) completion of twenty-six (26) Round 2 Sites (Round 2 Sites) to add to the Public Safety Broadband Network (PSBN) for inclusion in the National Public Safety Broadband Network (NPSBN).
