To Whom It May Concern:

Massachusetts Technology Park Corporation (MassTech) requests a period of performance extension until January 31, 2014 to continue the successful implementation of our Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP) award. This request includes this project's extension rationale and provides supporting documentation as attachments to the Award Action Request (AAR).

1) **Reason(s) for Extension Request: The** Massachusetts Technology Park Corporation has experienced circumstances that have caused the need for an extension beyond the original project end date. The narrative below provides an explanation of how the project-specific circumstances resulted in the need for a period of performance extension; our proposed plan for addressing any outstanding issues; and the project benefits that will be delivered during the extension period.

Mass Tech requests an extension from 6/30/13 to 1/31/14 to complete its BTOP project; in particular, to complete the installation of the final 90 miles of fiber and to connect 946 CAIs that MassTech will be unable to connect by the end of June 2013. Although MassTech will have completed 99% of make ready, 95% of fiber, and 24% of CAI connections by the end of June, it requests an extension to provide the time needed to complete the project.

An exceptional number of unforeseeable weather events have resulted in a cumulative impact of more than six months delay in completion of make-ready and the availability of constructible network segments. MassTech has documented these events, which included exceptional snowfall in 2010 and crews being diverted from MassTech to address emergencies associated with extreme weather events along the east coast in 2011 and 2012. MassTech also suffered delays due to environmental reviews that stalled construction, the effects of which rippled through the project timetable. While MassTech increased the number of installation work crews to compensate for some of the lost time, it will be unable to complete the project by the end of June.

MassTech will use the time granted in the extension to achieve the goals outlined and sustained in the grant, completing construction of the network and providing services to all 1241 CAIs in the project.

MassTech therefore respectfully requests a project extension until January 31, 2014.
