



#### Fringe Benefits

Fringe benefits are projected as a percentage of the personnel's annual salary calculated as follows: Employer's FICA Tax (7.65%), Unemployment Tax (.5%), Health/Dental/Vision Insurance (5.7%), Disability & Life Insurance (.6%), Accrued Paid Time Off (3.6%), SIMPLE match (3%), Gym benefit (.1%), and Professional Development (.3%). The total projected percentage cost will be 21.45% of the personnel salaries for years 1 through 5. Projected fringe benefit cost for CN staff for years 1 through 5 are \$6,761, \$7,030, \$7,142, \$7,429, and \$7,724 respectively. All fringe benefits for CN staff are being requested through federal funds.

State of Minnesota benefits are calculated at 28% of the personnel cost totaling \$2,360 for year 1 and \$1,452, \$1,503 and \$1,506 in years 3 through 5 respectively. All benefits for Minnesota employees are paid as an in-kind contribution from the state.

#### **Projected Travel Costs**

Minnesota travel costs consist of planned trips by the project manager for project oversight and stakeholder relations. Airplane travel cost is projected to be \$500 per roundtrip with 5 trips with a total cost of \$2,500 in year 1. In year 2, 3 trips are expected for a total cost of \$1,560 and 2 trips expected in each of years 3 through 5 for a total cost of \$1,082, \$1,125, and \$1,170, respectively. All travel costs for years 2 through 5 reflect a 4% annual inflation adjustment. Hotel room cost is projected to be \$200 per room with 5 nights' occupancy for a total cost of \$1,000 in year 1. In year 2, 3 nights' occupancy is expected for a total cost of \$624 and 2 nights' occupancy in each of years 3 through 5 for a total cost of \$433, \$450, and \$468, respectively. Rental car expense is projected to be \$90 per day with 10 days projected rentals in year 1 for a total cost of \$900 and with 6 days projected rental in year 2 for a total cost of \$562 and 4 days projected in each of years 3 through 5 for a total cost of \$389, \$405, and \$421, respectively. Per diem allowance for meals is projected at \$45 per day based on

the current standard federal per diem rate, with 10 days of travel in year 1 for a total cost of \$450 and with 6 days of travel in year 2 for a total cost of \$281 and 4 trips expected each of years 3 through 5 for a total cost of \$195, \$202, and \$211, respectively. Mileage travel cost is projected at \$.55 per mile, the current applicable standard federal rate, and average trips of 120 miles with 5 expected total trips in year 1 for a total cost of \$330, 3 expected trips in year 2 and 2 trips in each of years 3 through 5 for a total cost of \$206, \$143, \$148, and \$154, respectively. All travel costs are being requested through federal funds.


The Minnesota Ultra High Speed Broadband Task Force report, which will be released Friday, November 6, 2009, will serve as a baseline document for the mapping planning project. The task force averages 20 members in attendance and have met 11 times since February 17, 2009. The total number of meeting time hours over the course of those 11 meetings were 50 hours. Assuming an hourly rate of \$75 for each task force member, the inkind contribution in year 1 is \$75,000.

#### Indirect Costs

Indirect costs are included at a rate of 30%. While Connected Nation does not currently hold a federal indirect cost rate, CN has calculated its rate in anticipation of requesting an indirect cost rate from the Department of Commerce. Total indirect costs in year 1 are \$68,949 with \$36,766 paid by the state and \$32,183 requested from federal sources. Total indirect costs for year 2 are \$26,452 with \$0 paid by the state and \$26,452 requested from federal sources. Total indirect costs for year 3 are \$28,826 with \$0 paid by the state and \$28,826 requested from federal sources. Total indirect costs for year 4 are \$29,980 with \$0 paid by the state and \$29,980 requested from federal sources. Total indirect costs for year 5 are \$31,077 with \$0 paid by the state and \$31,077 requested from federal sources.

The total cost for personnel salaries for year 1 is \$172,840. Of this amount, \$4,842 is an inkind contribution from the state of Minnesota and \$167,998 is the requested federal share. The total cost for personnel salaries for year 2 is \$179,729. Of this amount, \$5,012 is an inkind contribution from the State of Minnesota and \$174,718 is the requested federal share. Through 9/30/09, CN has incurred pre-award costs related to personnel costs totaling \$4,100 all to be paid from federal sources.

Connect Minnesota may utilize other employees as needed to fulfill the requirements of this project.

#### Fringe Benefits

Fringe Benefits are projected as a percentage of the personnel's annual salary calculated as follows: Employer's FICA Tax (7.65%), Unemployment Tax (.5%), Health/Dental/Vision Insurance (5.7%), Disability & Life Insurance (.6%), Accrued Paid Time Off (3.6%), SIMPLE match (3%), Gym benefit (.1%) and Professional Development (.3%). The total projected percentage cost will be 21.45% of the personnel salaries. Projected fringe benefit cost for CN staff during is \$36,036 for year 1 and \$37,478 for year 2, all to be paid from federal sources. Through 9/30/09, CN has incurred pre-award costs related to fringe benefit costs totaling \$879, all to be paid from federal sources.

State of Minnesota benefits for the State of Minnesota staff are expected to be \$1,356 for year 1 and \$1,403 for year 2, all paid from an in-kind contribution from the state.

#### **Projected Travel Costs**

Airplane travel cost is projected to be \$500 per roundtrip with 23 trips expected in year 1 for a total cost of \$11,500 and 18 trips in year 2 for a total cost of \$9,360. All travel costs for year 2 reflect a 4% inflation adjustment. Hotel room cost is projected to be \$200 per room with 45 night's occupancy in year 1 for a total cost of \$9,000 and with 40 night's occupancy in year 2 for a total cost of \$8,320. Rental car expense is projected to be \$90 per day with 68 days projected rental in year 1 for a total cost of \$6,120 and with 58 days projected rental in year 2 for a total cost of \$5,429. Per diem allowance for meals is projected at \$45 per day based on the current standard federal per diem rate, with 68 days of travel in year 1 for a total cost of \$3,060 and with 58 days of travel in year 2 for a total cost of \$2,714. Mileage

travel cost is projected at \$.55 per mile, the current applicable standard federal rate, and average trips of 120 miles with 23 expected trips in year 1 for a total cost of \$1,518 and 18 expected trips in year 2 for a total cost of \$1,236.

The Minnesota travel costs consist of planned trips by 5 different categories of employees or consultants:



Through 9/30/09, CN has incurred pre-award costs related to travel costs totaling \$1,914, all to be paid from federal sources.

#### Equipment

ESRI ArcInfo and ArcGIS software will be purchased and used to map the broadband and Community Anchor Institution data received. ESRI is the industry leader in GIS software. ArcInfo and other ESRI resources will allow Connect Minnesota to process the multitude of data formats that are received from the various broadband providers who have different levels of digital data available for their networks. This software will be purchased in the first

year as soon as possible upon receipt of funding with annual maintenance in the second year.






Through 9/30/09, CN has incurred pre-award costs related to materials and supplies totaling \$1,395, all to be paid from federal sources.

#### Other

Connect Minnesota will create an outreach campaign for the primary purpose of verification of data. CN will target media outlets in Minnesota that can reach the greatest number of individuals in an outreach effort to drive them to Minnesota's interactive maps and speed test tools. CN has been able to leverage outreach campaigns with media outlets in such way that for every outreach campaign it is expected 1 will be provided in-kind. We plan to target 8 outlets in year 1 and 4 outlets in year 2 with a total cost of \$40,000 and \$20,800 respectively. Of the year 1 cost, \$20,000 will be provided in-kind from the media outlets. Of the year 2 cost, \$10,400 will be provided in-kind from the media outlets. The federal share cost requested would be \$20,000 in year 1 and \$10,400 in year 2. The costs for year 2 reflect a 4% inflation adjustment.

Connect Minnesota Broadband datasets will contribute its datasets related to the current Minnesota maps. The estimated fair market value of the datasets comprising the Minnesota broadband maps is \$441,001.

State of Minnesota datasets will be used and will consist of addresses/connectivity and some GIS data for as many as 800 state sites. While not totally comprehensive in each area, it includes libraries, hospitals, K-12, county courthouses, and partial data for affiliated county organizations and state law enforcement. The estimated value of the datasets is \$816,192. This value is estimated based upon historical cost to build a similar Community Anchor

Institution dataset in another state on a per capita basis and considering the percent of data captured in the dataset.

The average work space square footage provided to state personnel in the State of Minnesota is 100 sq. ft. The cost per square foot per year in the building where the Minnesota Department of Commerce is located is \$19.65 through August 31, 2010 and will rise to \$20.24 for September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011. The state will provide office space at no cost to Connected Nation for 1 employee of the initiative. This amounts to a total annual value of \$1,965 in year 1 and \$2,044 in year 2.


Indirect costs are included at a rate of 30%. While Connected Nation does not currently hold a federal indirect cost rate, CN has calculated its rate in anticipation of requesting an indirect cost rate from the Department of Commerce. Total indirect costs in year 1 are \$777,263 with \$575,223 paid by the state and \$202,040 requested from federal sources. Total indirect costs in year 2 are \$193,613 with \$31,854 paid by the state and \$162,029 requested from federal sources.


Through 9/30/09, CN has incurred pre-award costs related to indirect costs totaling \$4,237, \$4,151 to be paid from federal sources and \$86 as an in-kind match.




