Motorola Solutions participated in a site visit with members of the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet) board, BayRICS executives, NTIA, a State of California representative, a representative from the Office of the Mayor of San Francisco, the Police Chief of City of San Francisco, director of San Francisco's Emergency Management Authority, and Motorola Solutions executives. The site visit participants reviewed the program performance to date and a evaluation of the ultimate integration of the BAYWEB network into the Nationwide Public Safety Broadband Network (NPSBN).

In addition, Motorola continues to support negotiations between the BayRICS Authority and potential backhaul providers. We continued efforts in support of site zoning and permitting process with local governing agencies. Motorola Solutions preserved the capacity to continue the project after the suspension is lifted.
