The Nevada Hospital Association encountered challenges in executing final agreements with State agencies and other network partners in the time frame previously projected. Additionally, a delay in fiber cable delivery has meaningfully altered the anticipated project time line. Fiber delivery is expected to commence in 2Q12. NHA is actively working through these matters with the relevant agencies to meet substantial project completion time lines. Lighting of network circuits and fiber construction is expected to begin in 3Q12.
