During the next quarter, NebraskaLink expects to complete their first of three fiber optic rings of our project. NebraskaLink will comlete their builds in the cities of Kearney, O'Neill and Valentine and bury approximately 50 miles of fiber build in the south western area of the state of Nebraska. We are expecting to lease an additional 12 miles of fiber and deploy an additonal 90 miles of fiber - weather permitting. We anticipate the addition of at least 9 more CAI's on our routes. We are currently working on adding 4 signed agreements with last mile provider or broadband wholesalers.
