This quarter we were able to seat 180 students in our Basic Computer Literacy Training. Classes are held during the week day, evening and weekend to accommodate a variety of schedules. Students must complete this basic class in order to receive the laptop and broadband connection. We were able to connect 107 total new subscribers who completed this class during the quarter. The remaining 73 were either still finishing the basic class or scheduled for installation after the guarter end.
