Our Team has collected drive test data covering ~3400 miles of Federal Aid roads in VT. The drive testing was completed in June of 2010. The data from the drive testing was received in September of 2010 and we are only now beginning to review the results and develop a verification plan for how (or if) we will integrate that data into the statewide coverage data set.

Additionally, field verification and public survey methods will continue for the duration of the grant as described in our original and supplemental grant proposals.

10h. If yes, please describe the status of your activities

The BMT used the data from a phone survey conducted by the UVM Center for Rural Studies (CRS) to verify the broadband maps. Respondents were asked to indicate whether they had broadband at their residence, and were asked to provide their address. The addresses were geocoded (mapped to a lat/long coordinate), then used to verify the broadband map. The final results of this analysis were not available as of 10/19/2010 (when VT\_Package\_Oct1\_2010\_v1.zip was released. The results will be bundled with "version 2".
