C. Executive Summary

7. Executive Summary of Overall Proposal:

A. Problem/Need Statement

- With 12.1% of its workforce unemployed, South Carolina has the 4th highest unemployment in the nation (US Department of Labor, BLS Statistics, June 2009).
- With only 39.1 % of its households having broadband access, South Carolina ranks 49th in the United States (US Census Bureau, Internet and Computer Use Supplement to the Current Population Survey, 2007).
- 20.6% of children in SC live in poverty, the 11th highest in the nation. (American Communities Survey, 2007).
- With only 56.5% of entering 9th graders graduating from high school, South Carolina is ranked 47th in the United States in high school graduation rates (National Center for Higher Education Management Systems, 2006).
- With 788 offences per 100,000 population, South Carolina ranks 1st in the nation in violent crime (Crime in the United States: 2007, Federal Bureau of Investigation).

Ranking among the last where we need to be first and among the first where we need to be last is a tragic reality for our struggling state. In South Carolina's rural communities and underserved urban areas, most residents do not have access to educational opportunities or workforce training, and have limited healthcare and entrepreneurial resources. High speed internet access and the skills to use it are critical for personal and professional health and prosperity; therefore expanding broadband access to these targeted populations will have a positive effect on all measures of health and welfare in South Carolina. The South Carolina Technical College System, comprised of sixteen comprehensive technical and community colleges, has developed a broad-based approach to expanding broadband access through Public Computer Centers. This PCC proposal and its partner Sustainable Broadband Adoption proposal will stimulate broadband adoption, a critical first step toward improving South Carolina communities' health, education and economies, so that all South Carolinians can REACH FOR SUCCESS.

As community anchor institutions, the Colleges in our System are extremely well positioned to

provide expanded broadband access, but the lack of financial resources is an obstacle. South Carolina has been particularly hard-hit by the economic downturn. Within the past two years the state has cut allocations to our Colleges by 25%. These cuts have forced the Colleges to postpone replacements of technology equipment and reduce or eliminate service contracts. Colleges have little or no room in their budgets to support additional bandwidth or innovative approaches to explore the benefits of broadband use with less expensive devices. Federal stimulus funding is a necessity to make this project a reality.

B. Overall Approach

The SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges and partners, will work together to implement a three-pronged approach to expanding broadband access and use in South Carolina:

1. A statewide network of Public Computer Centers. Partner Colleges with service areas that include rural and underserved populations will open 19 new and 51 existing PCCs to the general public (see map in uploads section).
2. Increased bandwidth and expanded access for credit and continuing education students. Nearly a quarter of a million strong, the SC Technical and Community Colleges' students, many of whom are socially and economically disadvantaged, are a key target population for this project.
3. Public awareness campaign and training opportunities. The SC REACH FOR SUCCESS public awareness campaign will include a variety of radio and print marketing tools. Project staff will develop and offer in-person workshops and online training opportunities. Project partners will assist in disseminating information to target populations.

C. Areas and populations served (with demographic information) estimated number of users of PCCs.

A demographic profile of the PCC users will most likely mirror the state's overall population demographics. In 2008, the ethnic composition in South Carolina included 65.2% white, 28.1% African-American, 4.1% Hispanic, and 2.6% other races (US Census Bureau estimates). The South Carolina Technical College System currently serves 114,000 credit students and 128,000 continuing education students. Of students enrolled in the fall 2008 semester, 49.1% received federal Pell Grant assistance and 36.9% of credit students were minorities. We estimate the number of potential new users of the PCCs statewide will be more than 21,000 per year.

D: Qualifications demonstrating ability to implement project and achieve intended results. The SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges have: 1) a strong history of successful system-wide collaboration, 2) extensive experience administering federal and state grants, 3) existing broadband infrastructure, and 4) IT staff with qualifications and experience in implementing and administering broadband service. With existing campuses and training sites, no SC resident lives more than 30 miles from one of these locations (see map in uploads section).

E. Jobs saved or created.

This project will employ a minimum of 6 full-time employees and 65 part-time employees who will implement broadband infrastructure, administer PCCs and provide training.

F. Overall cost.

SC REACH FOR SUCCESS is requesting \$5,903,040 in BTOP funds. The System and its member Colleges will commit a 26.3% match of \$1,524,183 to broadband access, training and outreach.

D. Project Purpose

8. Project Purpose

South Carolina faces tremendous challenges: a damaged economy, a struggling education system, poor health among its poorest residents and communities in crisis. Broadband is a powerful tool for providing workforce development programs, education, and healthcare information, but broadband access is yet another sad statistic for South Carolina.

Economy-

- A 12.1% unemployment rate, the 4th highest unemployment in the nation (US Bureau of Labor Statistics, June 2009).
- The per capita income in South Carolina is the 6th lowest in the US at \$31,884 (US Bureau of Economic Analysis, March 2009.)
- 20.6% of children in South Carolina live in poverty (11th in the US) (American

Education-

- Only 56.5% of entering 9th graders graduate from high school (47th in the US) (National Center for Higher Education Management Systems, 2006).
- With only 34.5 GEDs produced for every 1,000 eighteen to twenty-four year olds without a high school diploma, South Carolina ranks 42nd in the US in GED production (National Center for Higher Education Management Systems, 2006).

Health-

- 29.0% of South Carolina’s residents suffer from obesity, the 7th highest rate in the nation (Risk Factor Surveillance System, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention).
- South Carolina has the 6th highest infant mortality rate in the US with 8.6 deaths per 1,000 live births (National Center for Health Statistics).
- The United Health Foundation gave South Carolina a score of -10.7, ranking the state 48th (America’s Health Rankings: 2008, United Health Foundation).

Community-

- With 788 offences per 100,000 population, South Carolina ranks 1st in the nation in violent crime (Crime in the United States: 2007, Federal Bureau of Investigation).

With its power to deliver tools, resources, training and education, broadband access has the potential to positively address many of the needs of South Carolina’s residents. Unfortunately, only 39.1% of South Carolina households have broadband access, the second lowest rate in the nation (US Census Bureau, Internet and Computer Use Supplement to the Current Population Survey, 2007).

Degree to which SC REACH FOR SUCCESS effectively addresses the lack of broadband access and usage. SC REACH FOR SUCCESS is a comprehensive approach to addressing the lack of broadband access and usage in South Carolina. Because the Colleges have campuses or training centers with broadband internet in virtually every county, much of the infrastructure needed to provide additional public access is already in place. In several counties, adding the proposed number of access points will more than double those currently available. Providing staff to assist users, along with a program of educational sessions provided free of cost to the public, will help overcome the barrier of insufficient training or expertise among potential users. The additional equipment and personnel for this project will effectively provide access at a relatively low cost. The many component projects and activities of SC REACH FOR

SUCCESS have been on the Colleges’ “drawing boards” and are the equivalent of “shovel ready.”

SC REACH FOR SUCCESS will advance the 5 BTOP Statutory Purposes:

1. Providing broadband access to consumers in unserved areas. SC REACH FOR SUCCESS will open 19 Public Computer Centers in areas where there is currently limited or no public access to broadband.
2. Provide improved broadband access to consumers in underserved areas. SC REACH FOR SUCCESS will expand broadband access at 51 rural and/or underserved centers.
3. Provide broadband education, awareness, training, access, equipment and support to community anchor institutions, job-creating strategic facilities, and vulnerable populations. SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges are community anchor institutions which serve vulnerable populations. The Colleges will acquire broadband equipment and digital network technology for broadband services; expand access to existing training and education and develop new training programs; and will conduct broadband-related outreach and awareness campaigns.
4. Improve access to and use of broadband by public safety agencies. Through SC REACH FOR SUCCESS, the 13 Criminal Justice and 5 Emergency Medical Technology degrees and the many continuing education programs for public safety personnel will be more accessible to rural residents. Proposed SC REACH FOR SUCCESS activities include providing free or reduced cost workshops for staff at the federal and state prisons, and programs for youth in underserved areas conducted by public safety officials.
5. Stimulate demand for broadband. The project’s hands-on workshops and its public awareness campaign will both focus on increasing interest in and adoption of broadband for new users.

Replication Opportunities

All of the SC REACH FOR SUCCESS projects and activities can be replicated. A significant strength of this proposal and its partner SBA proposal is that the System’s mechanisms for cooperation and collaboration allow for seamless replication of demonstration projects. The Colleges and system staff will provide technical and programmatic assistance, workshop and awareness campaign materials to each other and current and future partners. A statewide advisory team will evaluate and make recommendations to the project management team on the project best practices to be replicated across the system. The SC TECH REACH Portal will share all project information with project partners and other interested entities around the country.

users aware of the REACH Portal and providing training on its use. Additionally, PCC users will receive information on the schedules and availability of the REACH-MC and the 19 PCC-Cart systems. The REACH-MC, and PCC-Cart systems will be available for use by project partners and their constituencies, in particular the HBCU partners.

9. Recovery Act and Other Governmental Collaboration.

The ARRA goals are much like the goals of our two-year Colleges: to raise Americans from economic crises and lay the foundation for opportunity and growth. SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges will leverage BTOP funds as they have leveraged all funding sources for over 40 years. The Colleges in the System have a long history of collaboration with all levels of government as well as private partners and donors to maximize services, projects and institutional efficiencies.

All REACH Colleges will use ARRA and state funding to leverage this grant.

1. ARRA/ Fiscal Stabilization funds for SC. \$20.2 million to REACH Colleges. Faculty, staff, all academic programs, libraries, academic success and counseling centers would have been severely cut without these funds.
2. DOL/WIA. \$4 million to SC Technical College System for Quickjobs training that results in an industry recognized credential or certificates in 6 to 12 months. Many of these courses will be offered at PCC campuses or training sites.
3. Energy Efficiency Training Centers/ARRA/SC OEO Office. \$1.5 million to 6 REACH Colleges for Weatherization Training Centers to train individuals to analyze and retrofit low income homes and a “train the trainer” program for the other 10 Colleges to become training sites in phases. Home assessment and weatherization training will be offered at some of the PCC sites.
4. ARRA/SC Energy Office Energy Efficiency Funding. \$9.2 million grant plus \$3 million in loans to upgrade facilities with energy efficient equipment. Upgrades will affect PCC sites and possibly provide opportunities for credit courses and public awareness demonstration projects.
5. SC Education Lottery Technology Fund. \$5 million (FY 09). SC Legislative appropriation.

This amount fluctuates but this funding has been allocated to Colleges for each of the 8 years of the Lottery’s existence, providing a revenue stream for technology needs.

6. SC Allied Health Initiative. \$4 million SC Legislative appropriation. This amount fluctuates but this funding has been allocated for four years for our Colleges. These funds provide a revenue stream for the Colleges’ 20 Nursing and Allied Health fields of study.

7. SC Community Economic Development Act. \$1.4 million SC Legislative appropriation for certified Community Development Corporations. So far, grants totally \$490,000 have been awarded to 7 CDCs, many are already partners with our Colleges(See F 27 Key Partners list).

The South Carolina Broadband Coalition, of which the SC REACH for SUCCESS Colleges are members, is submitting a BTOP Infrastructure proposal: Palmetto State Integrated Fiber Infrastructure (PSIFI). The proposal is to build a comprehensive fiber based backbone throughout SC. If PSIFI is funded, SC REACH FOR SUCCESS will leverage the infrastructure project to enhance last-mile subscribership.

10. Enhanced Services for Health Care Delivery, Education, and Children

The SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges propose to enhance broadband services for health care management, education and children beyond simply providing access to broadband service in the PCCs and for our student populations. Due to limited access and lack of information, many online resources are only theoretically available to all South Carolinians now. Hundreds of thousands of residents aren’t taking advantage of online resources because they lack high speed internet access –and too often they don’t perceive broadband as affordable, usable or relevant to their lives.

Health: In South Carolina, where more than 600,000 residents live in medically underserved areas and diseases such as diabetes are record-setting, the lack of broadband access is particularly acute. Through expanded broadband access, SC REACH FOR SUCCESS will increase the number of students who are able to pursue health care training for future employment. New PCC high-speed remote access points will become available in many rural areas of the state for the first time and underserved populations will have access to training close to their homes. Combined, the Colleges in the system offer over 100 credit nursing and allied health programs. Additionally, the Colleges will offer numerous short-term training

programs in healthcare disciplines through their continuing education (non-credit) divisions.

Project faculty and staff will also introduce PCC participants to powerful online health care management tools in comfortable, non-threatening settings. Short, on-site, hands-on workshops, which are sometimes offered through hospitals or educational organizations in urban areas, will be offered to rural residents. Training will include how to use MyMedicare.gov, and how to access insurance/benefit information and other healthcare information online.

Education: PCCs will make new and existing educational opportunities at all levels more readily available, particularly to rural South Carolinians. Through new and existing partnerships, the proposed PCC's will provide a suite of web-based resources beyond those currently provided by the Colleges that can be leveraged at no additional cost for both K-12 and adults. A host of educational resources are available now, and the colleges have a comprehensive distance learning program. The missing link is public access to broadband connections.

Children: At select PCCs school children can connect at no cost to the PLATO Learning Resources for 2nd grade through adult learning, language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, and math. Colleges will be able to provide SC Education and Economic Development Act resources at the PCCs: Kuder for Adults, Connect to Business, and the South Carolina Career Planning System for K-12 applications, as well as statewide library resources, such as DISCUS. Additionally, the SC TECH REACH Portal component of our SBA proposal will increase the connectivity and on line resources for children.

11. Small and Disadvantaged Business Involvement

The SC REACH FOR SUCCESS Colleges regularly partner with socially and economically disadvantaged small businesses. Our System office submits an annual plan outlining agency goals for Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) participation and files quarterly progress reports to the SC Office of Small & Minority Business Assistance (OSMBA). During FY 2009 the System reported the actual awards of 57 contracts to minority and/or female owned and otherwise qualified business enterprises. These contracts totaled \$519,637.23. The criteria for SC MBE is more stringent than the SBA definition of a Small Disadvantaged Business.

SC REACH FOR SUCCESS currently has an agreement with Crescent Strategies, LLC, which is owned and operated by Dr. Robin Chisolm-Davis, to assist in the research, development and outreach phases of this project. Dr. Chisolm-Davis will continue to work with SC REACH FOR SUCCESS through at least the first year of project implementation. Dr. Chisolm-Davis meets both the SC MBE and the federal SDB criteria.

12. Public Computer Centers Availability

The 16 Colleges that comprise the South Carolina Technical College System (SCTCS) will expand or create 19 new Public Computer Centers and expand 51 PCCs that currently operate across the state, effectively providing the ability to utilize broadband resources across all counties in South Carolina. Placement of the PCCs will provide broadband to rural communities throughout the state that would otherwise not have access to broadband resources. As public institutions, the Colleges and their partners will make PCC facilities and resources available to the public in accordance with system and campus policies. In many instances, funds may be used to provide additional week-day or week-end hours as indicated in each PCC's proposed data.

The SCTCS serves over 114,000 credit students and 128,000 continuing education students each year. The majority of this student population is at-risk and vulnerable, including first-generation, low-income, disabled, discharged military, and academically under prepared. The PCCs will provide additional and extended access to those populations through innovative programs and center access with mobile computer and broadband options.

Beginning in 2010, every County in South Carolina will have a dedicated two-year college presence. Availability of resources may vary somewhat between Colleges and PCCs due to size

and space limitations. While most of the PCCs will provide open and unrestricted public access, some Colleges will expand their existing computer facilities to provide dedicated portions of larger student computer labs located at both main and branch campuses that will serve at-risk and vulnerable populations. Although many PCCs will accommodate public access across all age groups, some PCCs may be restricted in serving young children. Additional partnerships, such as public libraries and K-12 community technology centers funded by the South Carolina Department of Education, may exist in those cases to serve that age group.

The PCCs will not charge the general public membership dues or other fees for using the PCCs. However, Colleges and PCCs may charge routine fees, for things such as IDs and printing, that promote the safe and efficient operation of both the PCCs and their campuses. The Colleges expect that many of the patrons, or their family members, will enroll in courses once they are exposed to opportunities that exist on College campuses. This additional tuition revenue will help sustain the PCCs after the grant period ends.

This increase in public accessibility is projected to provide access to 21,700 additional South Carolina citizens.

13. Restrictions on Public Computer Center Use

Restrictions based on age may be provided in some PCCs to ensure an atmosphere conducive to study and research. Any appropriate public use of the PCCs will be allowed by policy. It should be noted that in some PCCs the amount of bandwidth devoted to some applications may be limited by packet-shaper software to ensure that all patrons have equitable access to necessary applications. No other restrictions are anticipated at this time.

14. Public Computer Centers Accessibility

As described in its Mission Statement, the South Carolina Technical College System is committed to “equal and affordable access to lifelong learning opportunities.” Providing access to persons with disabilities is integrated throughout all systems and services at each of the 16 technical and community Colleges. As community anchor institutions, the 16 technical and community Colleges of South Carolina strive to maintain an open and welcoming environment for disabled students. ADA accessible doors are available at all campuses and elevators are

present on campuses with multiple floors.

The Public Computer Centers will operate in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 by providing reasonable accommodations to people with disabilities. Each College has an existing compliance officer who ensures that each site makes every effort to provide access to educational opportunities in its programs. The Compliance Officer for each College will provide assistance to each of the PCCs operating under the College’s oversight. In addition, PCCs will standardize on Microsoft accessibility features, including text-to-speech and other features to help people with low vision and an onscreen keyboard for mobility-impaired users.

Other site-specific software or hardware features that enhance accessibility that may be used among the PCCs include:

- Online course management system accessibility for persons with disabilities who are using assistive technology
 - Closed-caption “How to” videos on using various database search engines
 - Aladdin Rainbow screen magnification instruments by Telesensory
- Read Write software for non-proficient readers

17. Public Computer Centers Outreach

The 16 Colleges that comprise the South Carolina Technical College System (SCTCS) have a demonstrated and nationally recognized track record working with at-risk and vulnerable populations, including the rural communities they serve. Each of the proposed Public Computer Centers expands each College’s outreach with existing or new training sites where critical partnerships and networks have already been established. The successful system outreach model used in other initiatives and with similar populations utilizes rural churches and grassroots non-profit organizations to help market programs and recruit participants. It also uses the state’s public agencies. These agencies include: public libraries, public safety

agencies, public and private hospitals, local workforce investment boards, the SC State Department of Education, SC Adult Education, SC Chamber of Commerce, state agencies that serve small businesses and disadvantaged or minority populations, and numerous local outreach partnerships and alliances. (A sample of these strategic partnerships is represented in letters of support included in the supporting documentation of this grant.)

The project will implement a strategic awareness campaign that supports continued use and growth in demand for the training and services proposed. In addition to partnership dissemination efforts listed above, each College student body will be made aware of the program and the specific needs it addresses. The outreach of this effort alone is extensive since the SCTCS serves over 114,000 credit students and 128,000 continuing education students each year. The majority of this student population is at-risk and vulnerable, including first-generation, low-income, disabled, discharged military, and academically under prepared. Students will be encouraged to participate in the broadband training series and to seek one-on-one assistance at the PCCs as needed through the college websites and other digital media, as well as print and radio media to advertise the PCCs including hours of operation, available services and training programs.

Colleges will communicate the program benefits to their student bodies through strategic communication tools including a dedicated email service which is the official communication link between the Colleges and their students, websites accessed frequently by students for their grades, mail correspondence, announcements at student organization meetings, electronic student newsletters, and posters in student common areas. Faculty will also be briefed on the program and asked to encourage their students to participate. Colleges will also conduct local workshops and advertise them to their constituencies.

Through this systematic and statewide effort, the project has a unique opportunity to influence and educate a large portion of the current and future labor force and leaders on broadband use, but not without additional funding.

18. Public Computer Centers Peripherals and Equipment

In the grant request there are three different types of computers specified based on location and community needs; desktops, laptops, and notebooks.

(1) The desktops are full function with 17” or 19” monitor, keyboard, mouse, and DVD/CDRW. They have standard 10/100/1000 Ethernet ports. They connect to the network at each location via category 5 cabling.

(2) The Laptops have monitors that are between 14.1” and 17”, DVD/CDRW. They have external mice for those not comfortable with a laptop touchpad. They are capable of connecting to the network via 10/100/100 Ethernet port or Wi-Fi.

(3) The Netbooks have monitors between 9” and 12”, no internal DVD/CD drive, and adequate USB ports to connect many devices. They have external mice for those not comfortable with a touchpad. All Notebooks connect using Wi-Fi although most also have a standard 10/100 Ethernet port.

For the LANs at all sites there are only two types of configurations. The fixed desktop labs are hardwired to switches. The Laptop/Netbook installation consists of a Wi-Fi network. The Access Points are connected to switches with PoE (Power of Ethernet). PoE minimizes the installation time and power wiring cost.

The Broadband at each location is DIA, MPLS Metro-E, or T1 line(s). Since only two sites required routers, the remainder are either using existing routers or layer 3 switches.

19. Public Computer Centers Workstation Software

The standard software may vary and version will most likely change over time. However, below is the most likely software based on the configurations at the Colleges. Each computer will have:
