Question 36: Budget Narrative

Please see the revised response below.

Personnel: \$901,660

The personnel costs in this budget are for operations, outreach and oversight of the project. Operations staff such as the BTOP Project Director, will lead day-to-day efforts to complete stated goals and deliverables. Outreach staff such as the SBA marketing team, will do the tasks that will lead to the goals and deliverables as outlined in the project. Oversight staff such as the Oversight Board, will provide strategic guidance to the overall efforts of the project.

Fringe: \$376,830

Fringe costs for the majority of the staff - paid directly by UW-Extension (UWEX), are calculated using the UWEX estimated two year average (40%) of the federally approved fringe rate. Rates vary for other staff and are determined by the partner organization.

Travel: \$15,842

Travel costs are estimated using the UW System approved reimbursement rates for mileage, meals and overnight accommodations. The majority of this budget line item is

for BTOP staff to travel to the 5 sites around the state. The remainder of this budget line item is for the Wausau mobile lab to provide outreach to farms and rural populations.

Equipment: \$122,743

A majority of these costs are for 114 laptops that will be used in 4 of 5 community sites. Most of the laptops will be used in mobile lab settings. Some of the equipment will be used to create a PCC in the Neighbor's Place in Wausau and the Senior Center in Platteville.

Supplies: \$20,147

Slightly over 50% of this budget line item will be used to support the central operations for this project for items such as general office supplies and used office furniture. The rest of the budget is for supplies for the Neighbor's Place lab and general office supplies for the Wausau Broadband Coordinating Instructor.

Contractual: \$74,282

Most of this budget is payment to First Research to complete oversampling surveys in the 5 demonstration communities where this project is taking place. The balance of this budget is for contractual costs to help develop and prepare the grant application.

Other: \$1,304,596

A majority of this budget provides for subcontracts with CESA 10, College of the Menominee Nation, UW-Platteville, and Superior School District to support the local education efforts in the uses of broadband. Other major budget items include space rental costs for central staff, conference/meeting costs for development of a "How to" manual, teleconference costs to meet with the 5 sites, production of educational videos and advertising costs.
