As Territorial Director of the Division of Libraries, Archives, and Museums (DLAM), I want to heartily endorse the pursuit of this troadband grant to create territory-wide comprehensive communities infrastructure broadband programs. Through the broadband initiative, it is the intent of the grant partners to seek means of providing enhanced Internet access and direct digital content availability through a bold broadband outreach initiative funded in part by the BTOP Public Computer Center program and matching funds pledged by the Government of the Virgin Islands.

The proposed Virgin Islands Public Computer Centers implementation would in part depend on the expansion of the broadband connectivity to the libraries and other centers proposed by the Communities Centers Initiative program. The Public Computer Centers will be augmented with self-service and on-line managed reference support services. These adjunct services may be administered with the referral assistance and guidance of volunteer on-site personnel or utilizing on-line querics to one of our participating library facilities.

As you are aware, the University of the Virgin Islands is the only institution of higher education in the U. S. Virgin Islands. The University is not only supportive of the comprehensive community infrastructure broadband program, but also anticipates being one of the primary consumers of the new capacity, and we are prepared to be responsive to the demand for expanded educational and training opportunities to provide residents with the specialized new skills that will be needed if members of the workforce are to optimally utilize the new network's most sophisticated features.

Currently, UVI is the largest consumer of broadband in the Territory. Yet we are hampered by the cost of access to the mainland and the limited capacity between our two campuses, one located on St. Thomas and the other on St. Croix. The capacity of the new middle mile between the proposed aggregation point at the NAP of the Americas, the UVI campuses on St. Thomas and St. Croix, the UVI Environmental Research Station (VIERS) on St. John, and the Research and Technology Park (RTPark) incubator facility at 64 West is immense compared to our current facilities.
